Metrolinx requires three Research Analysts to join a team of professionals engaged in transportation and transit policy development and project implementation analysis.

Metrolinx was established under the *Greater Toronto Transportation Authority Act, 2006* to address the significant transportation challenges in the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA). Metrolinx is mandated to provide leadership in the coordination, planning, financing and development of an integrated, multi-modal transportation network in the region. Building on the goals and policy frameworks of the Greenbelt and Places to Grow, Metrolinx is responsible for the development of the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) and associated Transportation Investment Strategy and rolling five-year capital plan.

The RTP will build on the Premier's transit vision for the GTHA, announced in June, 2007 – MoveOntario 2020 – which identified the role of Metrolinx for guidance on project selection, prioritization and timing, as well as any desired modifications to the list. Metrolinx is now working to move these and other projects from vision to implementation, while ensuring that each of the investments are compatible with a long-term plan for an integrated transportation system for the GTHA.

The Strategic Initiatives and Investments Unit is responsible for developing a financially sustainable Investment Strategy and capital plan, as well as assessing projects for implementation. The Strategic Technology Unit is responsible for working with our transit and transportation partners in the areas of service improvement and technology, including our role in the Presto smart card project, transit vehicle procurement and cross-boundary fare integration and service coordination.

Reporting to the Senior Policy and Planning Advisor, the Research Analyst's responsibilities will vary, but could generally include:

- Research related to international best practices in public capital investment
- Policy development
- Economic/financial analysis
- Review and monitoring of project implementation
- Production of charts and slides for use in documents and presentations
- Development of briefing materials and presentation of findings to senior staff
- Other duties as assigned

Excellent oral and written communication skills are essential, in addition to critical thinking skills and an interest in urban planning and transportation. The applicant should be proficient with word

processing, spreadsheet, and knowledge of graphic presentation software packages would be considered a great asset.
