# PRESTO Rollout on TTC Streetcars

On track to have PRESTO fare validators at all doors on all in-service **legacy streetcars** (approximately 230) and all available new **streetcars** by the end of December 2015.

PRESTO is now available on 11 new streetcars, and fare validators are currently being installed on legacy streetcars.

# TTC PRESTO Devices

**Self-Serve Reload Machines** are available at GO Transit's York Concourse, three UP Express stations, and 21 TTC subway stations that have PRESTO fare validators (including Union Station).

By the end of the year, these machines will be at 23 of the TTC subway stations with PRESTO fare validators.

# TTC Subway Faregate Testing and Rollout

Field trials of the **new TTC subway faregate** will begin at Main station during the first quarter of 2016.



When the field trials are complete, installation of these new faregates will begin in TTC subway stations.

As the TTC replaces its turnstiles with faregates, all 69 subway stations will be PRESTO enabled. This is scheduled for the end of 2016.



# TTC Bus Testing and Rollout



**Testing to begin on TTC buses** before the end of 2015.

One PRESTO fare validator will be installed on each of the 10 different types of TTC buses during the testing period.



Rollout will occur by bus depot (seven bus depots, plus a Wheel Trans depot) over a 6-8 month period beginning late spring 2016.

All bus entrances will be equipped with PRESTO fare validators.

# Para Transit Rollout

A pilot to test new **PRESTO mobile fare validators on YRT para transit vehicles** was completed in October 2015.

PRESTO is now focused on formalizing the program for use by all PRESTO transit agency clients on their para transit vehicles and contracted third-party operators (e.g. taxis) beginning with the TTC's Wheel Trans network in late 2016.

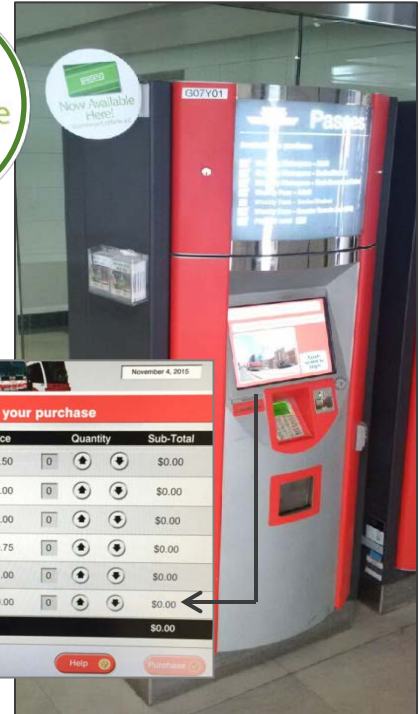


# PRESTO Card Distribution



A six-month pilot launches in December to **sell pre-loaded PRESTO cards at Gateway Newstand stores** located in five TTC subway stations.

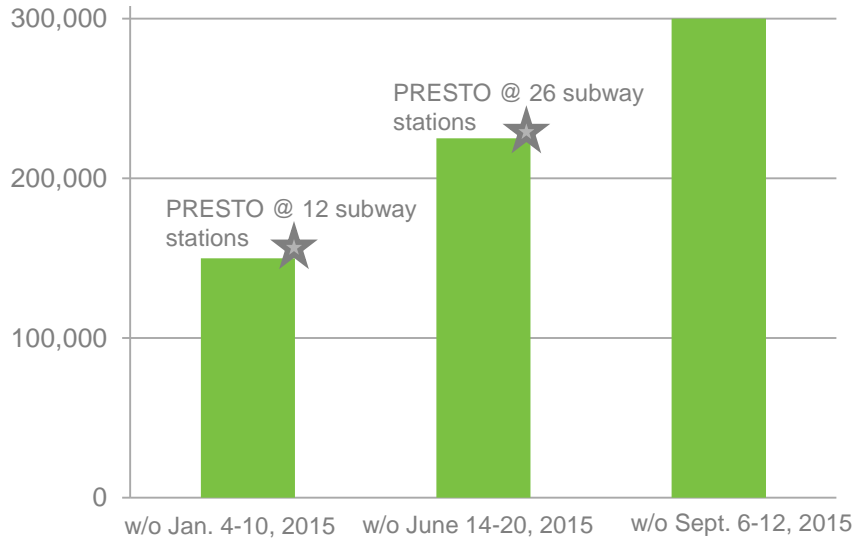

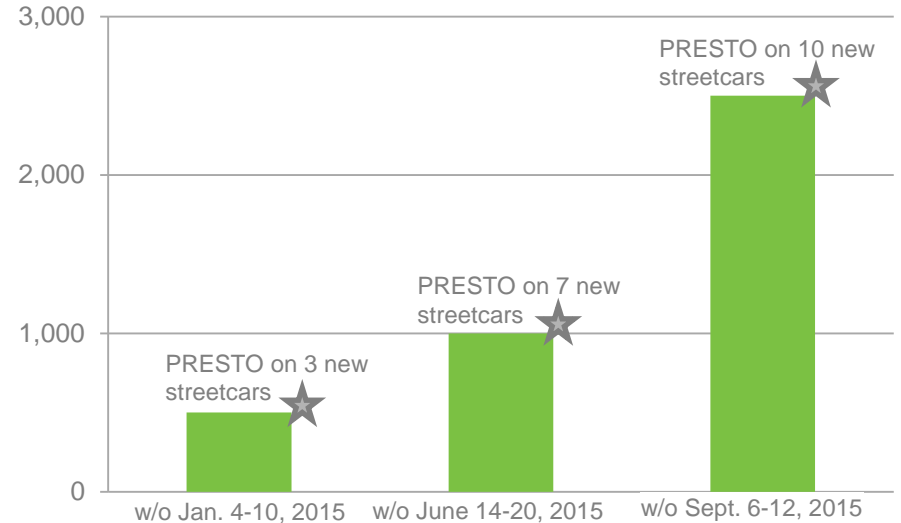
# PRESTO Usage on the TTC – 2015 Snapshot
