Subject: Metrolinx GO STOP PROPOSAL. A stop needed at Parklawn. (Humber Bay Shores)

To whom it may concern,

I am the President of Bal Harbour, Condo Corp TCECC 1558 situated at Lakeshore Blvd West and Legion Road comprising of 63 town houses on Yachters Lane, Legion Road and Lakeshore.

In the past few years there has been incredible growth in the Humber Bay Shores area with many new condominium buildings still under construction. Traffic congestion has become a major issue. The TTC express bus in the mornings can take 20 minutes just to travel 1 kilometre and the 501 streetcar takes an hour to get to downtown. The Mimico Go train station is some distance away, too far for many to walk and scarce parking. This station was probably ideally located years ago to serve the residents of Mimico but now proves to be too far west to serve Humber Bay Shores.

There was a proposal for a new Go station at Parklawn Road, possibly on the old Christie bakery premises. We were expecting this proposed new station to be a priority but this now doesn't seem to be the case despite the City deeming Parklawn and Lakeshore a major congested intersection. There is an urgent need to remove vehicular traffic from the highways by offering better public transit. Currently many local residents are forced to commute by car.

Our owners are disappointed that Parklawn Road is not on the list of proposed Metrolinx new Go stations and respectfully request that this location be reconsidered for a new station.
