Our Condominium Corporation, TSCC 1507, represents 259 residential units and 2 commercial units.

We understand a GO stop is being considered for the Humber Bay Shores Area. We advocate for, and strongly support, a decision to bring a GO Stop to this highly populated community. Within the next two years there are expected to be almost 40,000 residents in Humber Bay Shores, all of whom could be walking distance from the GO train. A station would be invaluable in reducing the congestion we are already experiencing daily.

A number of our residents signed an on-line petition to this effect. We also gathered the signatures of an additional 77 residents on a petition and provided this email to Humber Bay Shores Condominium Association (copy attached).
