RE: Park Lawn Rejection: page 17 of "Regional Express Rail Planning Update"

The Palace Pier is a 433 unit condominium located in Humber Bay Shores, a community in the Park Lawn / Lake Shore area.

Our Board supports a new GO station in our community for the reasons set out in the petition organized by the Humber Bay Shores Condominium Association ("HBSCA") and titled "GO Stop at Humber Bay Shores". A copy of the petition is attached.

In the recent SmartTrack and GO RER plan announcement, Park Lawn was not considered as one of the new stations / stops. This is extremely disappointing! On page 23 of "Appendix 2 – GO Regional Express Rail 10-Year Program: New Stations Analysis", in referring to four possible stations including Park Lawn, it was stated that MetroInx will continue to work with municipalities to improve the strategic, economic, financial, and operations cases for these locations and bring them forward for consideration. Our political representatives have - and will no doubt amplify on in meeting with your Board in July, the urgent need for a new Park Lawn area Go-Stop.

Through our political representatives, the Palace Pier Board of Directors is requesting that the decision to reject the Park Lawn proposed Go-Stop be re-evaluated. Thank you.
