Notice of tree removals

The Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT) is an 11-km LRT running along Finch Avenue West between Keele Street and Highway 27. When complete, it will increase capacity and reliability of service along the route, while significantly reducing travel times for transit users on the corridor.

What: As part of the construction of the Finch West LRT, tree removals are required for relocations of watermain on HWY 27 and storm sewers along Keele St and Finch Ave. Mosaic Transit Group (MTG), our constructor worked with an arborist to determine the trees that are to be removed. Tree protection fences will be placed around trees adjacent to work areas.

All removals have been approved by the City of Toronto. Upon the completion of the Finch West LRT, new trees will be planted in place of the removed ones in compliance with the City of Toronto's Tree Replacement Policy. The quantity and location of replacement trees will be decided with the city.

When: The trees are scheduled for removal starting in early September 2019, weather permitting.

Where: (Fig.1) On the east and west sides of Hwy 27 between Humber College Blvd and Finch Ave. W; and the north and south sides of Finch Ave W between Hwy 27 and Silver Stone Dr and **(Fig 2.)** between Signet Dr and Keele Street along Finch Ave. W.

Work Hours: Between 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, including weekends.




What to Expect:

- Tree removal on the north and south side of Finch Ave. W between Hwy 27 and Silver Stone Dr. and between Signet Drive and Keele St. as well as on the east and west side of Hwy 27 between Humber College Blvd and Finch Ave. W.
- Residents and businesses nearby should anticipate noise from chainsaws and wood chippers for the removal of trees.
- In addition to construction activity, residents can expect to see equipment and material storage within designated work zones.

Pedestrian and Traffic Details:

- Short-term, one-lane closures, as required.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained.
- Please take care when travelling near work sites.
