What is the Finch West Light Rail Transit?

The Finch West LRT is a light rail transit project that will bring 11 kilometres of modern, reliable rapid transit to northwest Toronto. It will have 18 stops, including 16 surface stops, plus an underground interchange station at Finch West subway. A below-grade terminal stop at Humber College will connect to other local transit services like GO, Miway, Viva, and Züm. The Finch West LRT will provide rapid transit for the Jamestown, Rexdale and Black Creek neighbourhoods, as well as vital connections between communities and supporting growth in northwest Toronto.

Installation of a Temporary Steel Plate to Cover Excavation and Relocation of Hydro Poles, from Romfield Ln. to Keele St. Late-October 2019.

What:

A crew will install a temporary steel plate over an excavated area (west of Keele St.) (Fig. 1) first, then relocate hydro poles on Finch Ave W., from Romfield Ln. to Keele St. (Fig.2) as part of the Finch West LRT project.

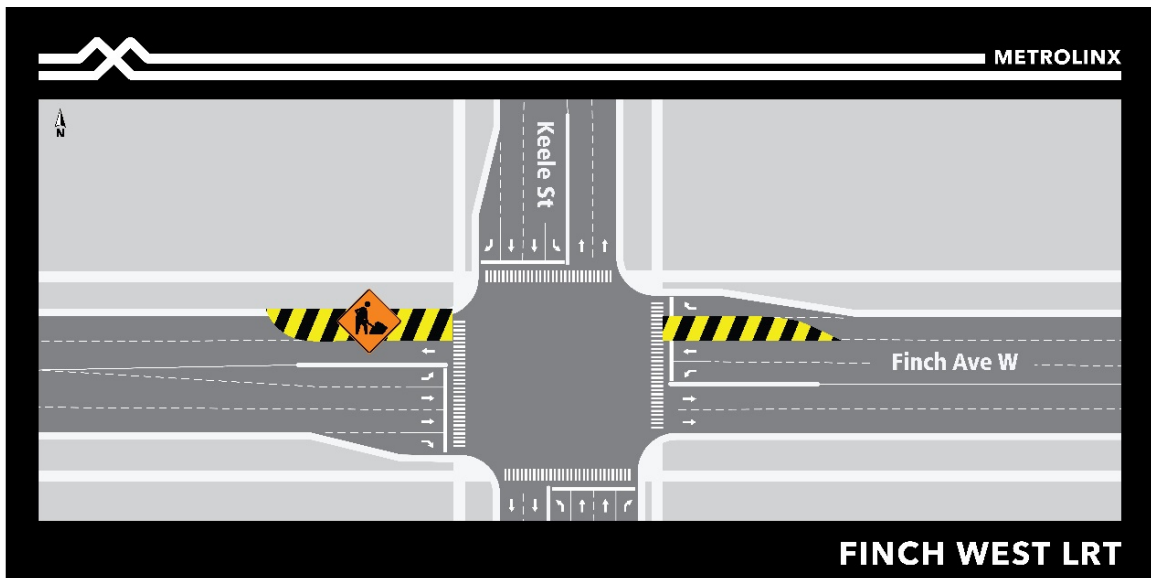
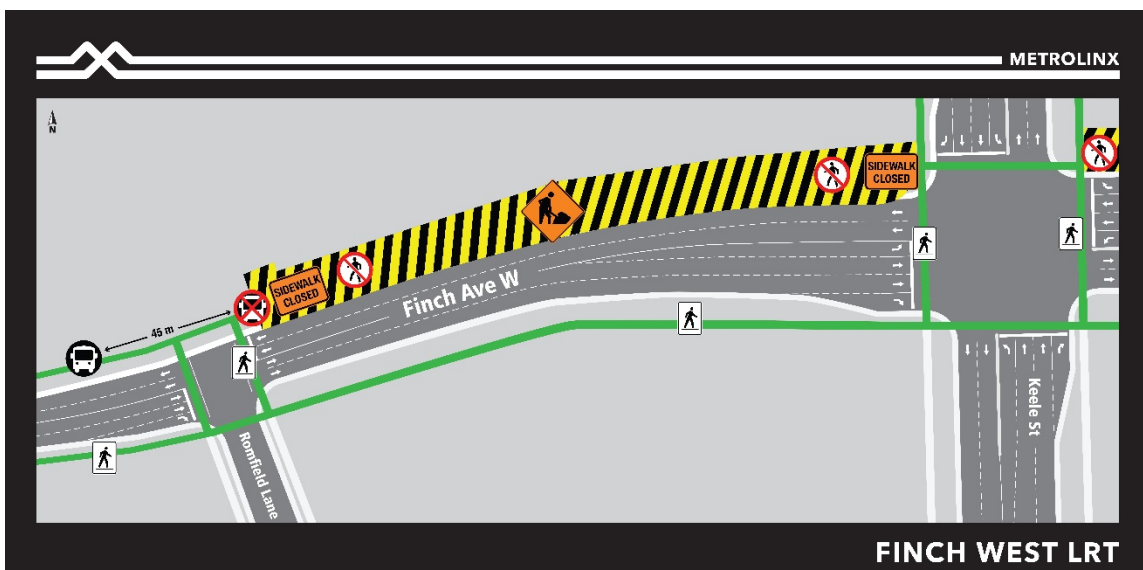

Hours of Work:

Fig 1:

- Work is expected to start in late-October 2019, and last for two (2) weeks, approximately.
- Will occur Monday to Friday between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

Fig 2:

- Work is expected to start once the installation of the steel plate is installed, and last for two (2) months, approximately.
- Work will occur Monday to Friday between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

What to Expect:

Fig 1:

- A crew installing a temporary steel plate on the north side of Finch Ave. W. (west of Keele St.)
- Short-term closure of westbound lane on Finch Ave. W. (east of Keele St.) at off-peak hours (9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.).
- Heavy trucks and equipment in the area.

Fig 2:

- A crew relocating three hydro poles on the north side of Finch Ave W., from Keele St. to James Cardinal McGuigan Catholic High School.
- Narrowed westbound lane on Finch Ave. W. (west of Keele St.)
- Sidewalk closure on the north side of Finch Ave. W., from Keele St. to James Cardinal McGuigan Catholic High School.
- Relocation of a TTC bus stop at Finch Ave. W. (north side) and Romfield Ln.
- Heavy trucks and equipment in the area.

Traffic, Pedestrian and Transit Impacts:

- Access to adjacent businesses and residences will be maintained.
- Please take care when travelling or walking near work sites.

Fig 1:

- Partial lane closures during off-peak hours (between 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.).

Fig 2:

- Traffic configuration will be in place for two (2) months, approximately.
- Narrowed westbound lane on Finch Ave. W. (west of Keele St.).
- The TTC bus stop # 2626 located at Finch Ave W. (north side) and Romfield Ln. will be relocated 45 metres west, approximately.
- Sidewalk closure on the north side of Finch Ave West from Keele St. to James Cardinal McGuigan Catholic High School. Sidewalk remains open on the south side of Finch Ave West.
