What is the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT)?

The Finch West LRT is a light rail transit project that will bring 11 kilometres of modern, reliable rapid transit to northwest Toronto. It will have 18 stops, including 16 surface stops, plus an underground interchange station at the TTC Finch West Subway Station. A below-grade terminal stop at Humber College will connect to other local transit services like GO, MiWay, Viva, and Züm. The Finch West LRT will provide rapid transit for the Jamestown, Rexdale and Black Creek neighbourhoods, as well as vital connections between communities and supporting growth in northwest Toronto.

Telecom Work from Hwy. 27 to Damascus Dr. /Kiskadee Dr. June 2020

What: As part of the Finch West LRT project, a crew will undertake telecom work on Finch Ave. W. and Hwy. 27 area:

- On the north side of Finch Ave. W. from Hwy. 27 to Damascus Dr. /Kiskadee Dr. a crew will rebuild a manhole and install underground duct banks.
- On the east side of Hwy. 27 from South of Humber College Blvd. to north of Finch Ave. W., transfer/Installation of new cable to new hydro poles will take place.

Information as of May 12, 2020

Hours of Work:

- Work is expected to start in June 2020 and last for five months, approximately.
- Work will occur Monday to Friday between 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

What to Expect:

- Crews will start at Finch Ave. W. and Hwy. 27 and move east towards Damascus Dr./Kiskadee Dr. Afterwards, work will start on the east side of Hwy. 27.
- Work will take place on the boulevard with daily curb lane closures between 9:00 am and 3:30 pm.
- Heavy trucks and equipment in the area.
- Some noise related to construction equipment.
- Expect delays near work zones.

Pedestrian Details:

- No sidewalk closures are expected. If needed for safety reasons, pedestrians will be re-routed around the work zone.
- Please take extra care when walking near work sites and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.

Traffic Details:

- A minimum of one (1) lane of traffic in each direction along Finch Ave. W. will be maintained.
- Expect short-term lane closures of the curb lane in the area from June to November 2020, between 9:00 am and 3:30 pm.
- Access to schools, churches, and businesses will be maintained.
- Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.

Bus Stop Relocations:

- TTC bus stops in the affected area will be relocated for the safety of transit riders. Please watch for posted signs indicating the adjusted locations.
- Relocation and re-routing of bus stops is done in consultation with TTC to ensure construction can continue safely while minimizing impact on the community and customers.
