


What is the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT)?

The Finch West LRT is a light rail transit project that will bring 11 kilometres of modern, reliable rapid transit to northwest Toronto. It will have 18 stops, including 16 surface stops, plus an underground interchange station at Finch West Subway Station. A below-grade terminal stop at Humber College will connect to other local transit services like GO, MiWay, Viva, and Züm. The Finch West LRT will provide rapid transit for the Jamestown, Rexdale and Black Creek neighbourhoods, as well as vital connections between communities and supporting growth in northwest Toronto.

Lane Reduction for Road Widening Along Finch Ave. W. from east of Tobermory Dr. to Jane St. Mid-June until late September 2020

What: As part of preparatory works to expand Finch Ave. W. to accommodate the Finch West LRT line, crews will begin to widen the south side of Finch Ave. W. from east of Tobermory Dr. to Jane St. Work will begin in mid-June and take approx. three (3) months

What is the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT)?

Hours of Work:

- Monday to Friday from **7 AM to 7 PM. Work will occur day, night and weekends, as required.**
- Work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

What to Expect:

- Road widening on the south side of Finch Ave. W. from east of Tobermory Dr. to Jane St.
- Reduced lanes
- Residents and businesses near construction sites should anticipate noise from excavators, bobcats, vacuum trucks and other heavy equipment.
- Some noise and dust related to construction.
- Expect delays near work zones.

Pedestrian Details:

- Sidewalks will remain open.
- Access to schools, churches, and businesses will be maintained.
- Please take extra care when walking near work sites, and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.

Traffic Details:

- The westbound lanes on Finch Ave. W. will be reduced from two to one lane.
- Two eastbound lanes on Finch Ave. W. will remain open but may be reduced to one lane if more space is required.
- A minimum of one (1) lane of traffic in each direction along Finch Ave. W. will be maintained at all times.
- Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.

Bus Stop Relocations/Closures:

- The following bus stops will be relocated to the edge of the construction zone as part of the road widening work:
 - Bus stop #2593.
 - Bus stop #2638.
 - Bus stop #2636.
- Please watch for posted signs indicating the adjusted locations.
- Relocation and re-routing of bus stops are done in consultation with TTC to ensure transit riders safety during construction.
- Access to the TTC will be maintained at all times
