

What is the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT)?

The Finch West LRT is a light rail transit project that will bring 11 kilometres of modern, reliable rapid transit to northwest Toronto. It will have 18 stops, including 16 surface stops, plus an underground interchange station at Finch West subway. A below-grade terminal stop at Humber College will connect to other local transit services like GO, Miway, Viva, and Züm. The Finch West LRT will provide rapid transit for the Jamestown, Rexdale and Black Creek neighbourhoods, as well as vital connections between communities and supporting growth in northwest Toronto.

Road Widening and Utility Work Along East of Hwy. 27 from South of Humber College Blvd. to Finch Ave. W. Late-July 2020

What: As part of preparatory works for construction of the Finch West LRT line, crews will begin activities to widen the road and install a storm sewer along the east side of Hwy. 27 from Humber College Blvd. to Finch Ave. W. That section of the Highway 27 is part of the Finch West LRT route. Work is anticipated to start in late-July 2020 and take approximately three (3) months.



Hours of Work:

- Monday to Friday from **7 AM to 7 PM**. Overnight and weekend work will occur, as required.
- Work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

What to Expect:

- Road widening and storm sewer installation on the east side of Hwy. 27 from Humber College Blvd. to Finch Ave. W.
- Heavy trucks and equipment in the area.
- Some noise and dust related to construction.
- Expect delays near work zones.

Pedestrian Details:


- The sidewalk on the west side of Hwy. 27 will remain closed between Humber College Blvd. and Finch Ave. W. Pedestrians will be re-routed through a residential neighbourhood on the west side of Hwy. 27.
- Access to schools, churches, and businesses will be maintained.
- Please take extra care when walking near work sites, and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.

Traffic Details:

- Occasional closure of the curb lane on Finch Ave. W., Hwy. 27 and Humber College Blvd.
- A minimum of one (1) lane of traffic in each direction along Hwy. 27, Finch Ave. W., and Humber College Blvd. will be maintained at all times.
- Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.

Bus Stop Relocations/Closures:

- The following bus stops remain closed/relocated as part of the ongoing work in the area. They will remain closed for three years to allow for the construction of the Finch West LRT in the area:
 - Bus stop #6761 and #8068 relocated until May 2023.
 - Bus stop #11293 and #11272 relocated until June 2023.



- Please watch for posted signs indicating the adjusted locations.
- Dates may change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
- Relocation and re-routing of bus stops are done in consultation with TTC, YRT, BT and Viva to ensure transit riders safety during construction.
- Access to the TTC, Zum and Viva will be maintained at all times
