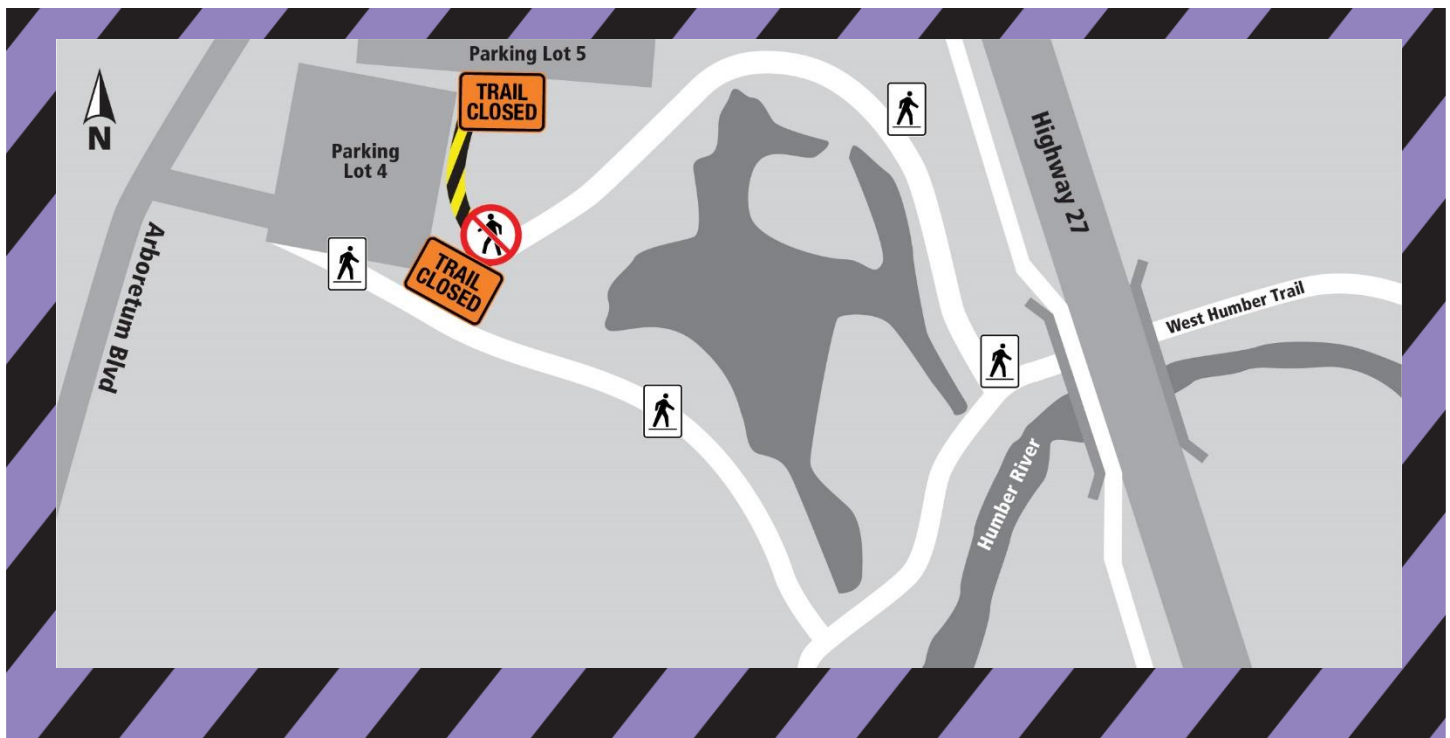


# UPDATE: Arboretum and West Humber Trails Reopen

Ongoing until late December 2020



## What?

As part of the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT) project, a crew continues to relocate utilities in the vicinity of the future Humber College Stop, located on the southwest corner of Highway 27 and Humber College Blvd. As part of that work, they are installing a new storm drain outfall in the ravine just west of Hwy 27 along the Arboretum Trail, located within the City of Toronto's right of way and regulated by Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA). Sections of the Arboretum Trail that were closed for the works are open, except for a small part between parking lots 4 and 5. It will remain closed until the work is complete in late December 2020. West Humber Trail also re-opened.

  
**WHEN AND WHERE:**

- Closure of a small section of the Arboretum Trail (see map above) until late December 2020, approximately.
- Pedestrians will be able to use most of the trail.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

**WHAT TO EXPECT:**

- Placement of erosion and sediment control devices before construction begins.
- Heavy trucks and equipment will be active in the work area.
- Excavation to install pipes.
- Please take care when walking near work sites.
