



FINCH WEST LRT – Transforming Transit in Your Area

Construction Notice

Information as of June 8, 2020

What is the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT)?

The Finch West LRT is a light rail transit project that will bring 11 kilometres of modern, reliable rapid transit to northwest Toronto. It will have 18 stops, including 16 surface stops, plus an underground interchange station at the TTC Finch West Subway Station. A below-grade terminal stop at Humber College will connect to other local transit services like GO, MiWay, Viva, and Züm. The Finch West LRT will provide rapid transit for the Jamestown, Rexdale and Black Creek neighbourhoods, as well as vital connections between communities and supporting growth in northwest Toronto.


Utility Work Highway 27 at Finch Ave. W. July 2020

What: A crew will relocate hydro poles and start preparatory work for an underground duct bank (a duct bank is a concrete structure that encases cable) as part of the Finch West LRT project.

Work will take place on:

- Hwy. 27, from 200 m. south of Humber College Blvd. to 200 m. north of Finch Ave. W.,
- Finch Ave. W., from 50 m. west of Hwy. 27 to 100 m. east of Westmore Dr., and
- Humber College Blvd., from Hwy. 27 to Arboretum Blvd.

Once relocated, outages will be required to switch power from the old to new infrastructure. Those directly affected by outages will be notified in advanced.



Hours of Work:

- Work is expected to start in July 2020 and last for five months, approximately.
- Work will occur Monday to Friday between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. However, lane disruptions will only take place off-peak hours.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

Information as of April 9, 2020

What to Expect:

- Hydro vac, pole installation, and cable stringing activities.
- Heavy trucks and equipment in the area.
- Some noise related to construction equipment.
- Expect delays near work zones.

Pedestrian Details:

- Pedestrian will be re-routed around the construction area when possible. When this cannot be done due to safety reasons, pedestrian will use the sidewalk on the opposite side.
- Please take extra care when walking near work sites and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.

Traffic Details:

- A minimum of one (1) lane of traffic in each direction along Finch Ave. W. will be maintained.
- Expect short-term lane closures of the curb lane in the area from July to December 2020.
- Access to schools, churches, and businesses will be maintained.
- Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.

Bus Stop Relocations:

- TTC bus stops in the affected area may be relocated for the safety of transit riders. Please watch for posted signs indicating the adjusted locations.
- Relocation and re-routing of bus stops is done in consultation with TTC to ensure construction can continue safely while minimizing impact on the community and customers.
