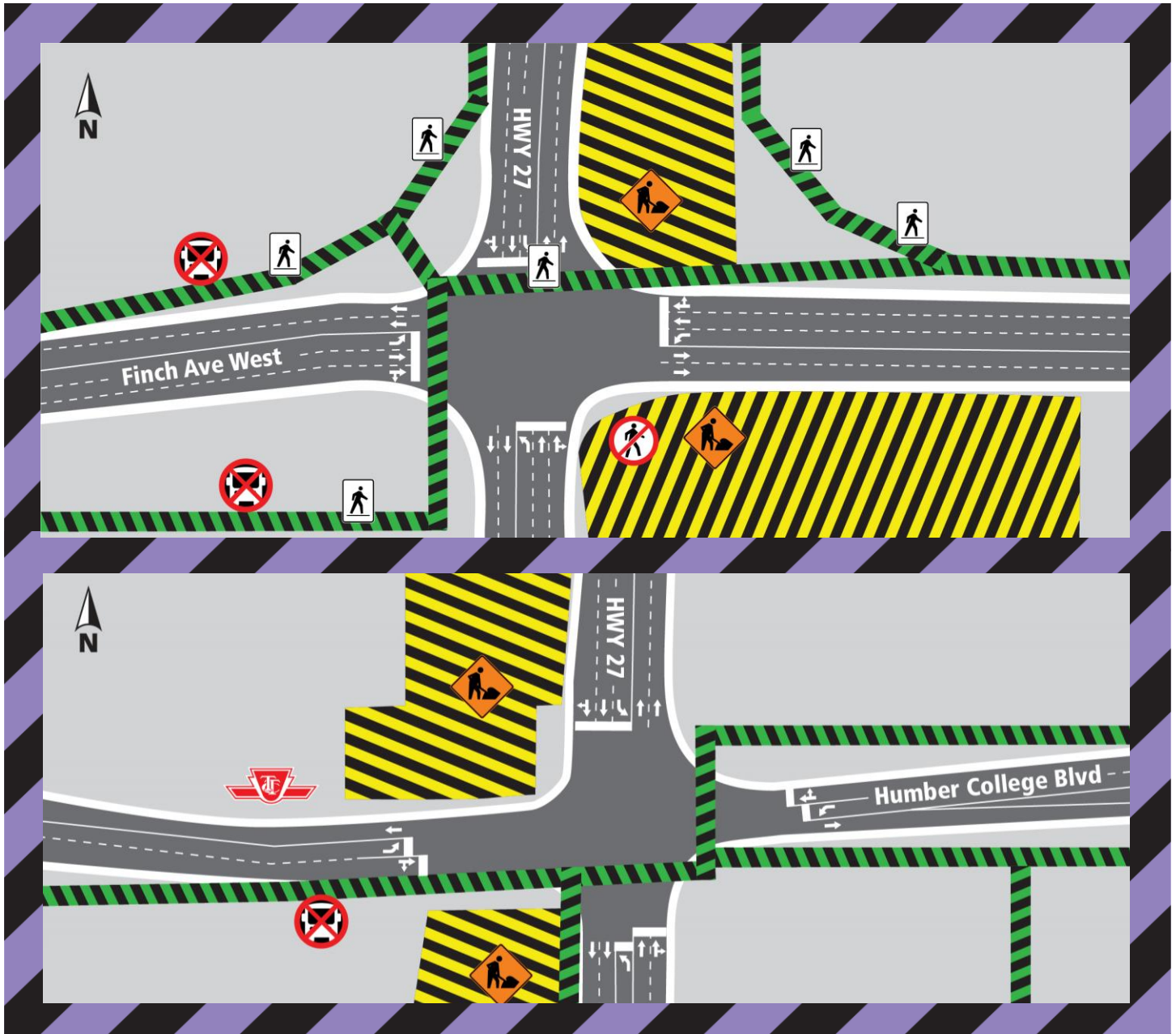


Installing Piles for the new Humber College Stop along Hwy 27, Finch Ave. W. and Humber College Blvd.

November 16, 2020 - Summer 2021



What?

The week of November 16, 2020, as part of the Finch West Light Rail (LRT) project, several crews will start support of excavation works for the future Humber College Stop, open cut tunnel and portal. Using auger machines, crews will drill holes into the ground and fill them with concrete and steel piles to create "columns" that will support excavation works as well as surrounding utilities or structures. Pile drilling will be conducted along Finch Ave. W. between Hwy. 27 and Westmore Dr. and along Hwy 27 to south of Humber College Blvd. Dry utility (e.g. electric, telephone, TV or internet cables) work also will be underway on Finch Ave. W. in the same area. Noise and vibration levels will be monitored throughout the work to make sure they are always within permitted ranges. During pile drilling, for public and workers' safety, traffic will be shifted on Hwy 27 to the east side, starting the week of November 16, 2020 and to the north side on Finch Ave. W at the end of November 2020. On Humber College Blvd, traffic will be shifted to the south. Those traffic shifts will remain in place till summer 2021.

Pile Drilling will continue into 2021.

WORK HOURS:

- Drilling will take place between 7:00 am to 11:00 pm, Monday to Saturday and overnight work as required to meet schedule.
- Work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

WHAT to EXPECT:

- Heavy trucks and equipment in the area.
- Noise and vibration from construction activity and equipment.
- Dust from drilling activity, which will be managed with water trucks during working hours.
- Traffic Control Plan is in place.
- Please obey all posted construction signs and do not enter the work zone.
- Please take extra care when walking near work sites, and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.
- Operational factors and weather may affect the schedule.
- Noise and vibration monitors are installed
- Noise and vibration monitors will be installed, as required

PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC and BUS STOPS DETAILS:

- Access to Humber College and businesses will be maintained.
- Access for Emergency Vehicles will be maintained.
- The south sidewalk on Finch Ave. W. between Hwy. 27 and Westmore Dr. will remain closed.
- Pedestrian access is available on the north sidewalk
- East and West Bound bus stops on Finch, W and Hwy 27 are closed. Bus stops # 9133 and 2600 are located on Finch W and Halesia Dr.
