

Enbridge Utility Relocation on Hurontario from Lancashire Lane to Steeles Avenue

Beginning Mid-September 2020



What work is taking place?

To accommodate construction of the Hurontario LRT, Enbridge Gas Inc. is required to install a new gas line on Hurontario Street from Lancashire Lane to Steeles Ave.

These pipelines are integral to Enbridge's gas system and must be re-routed to ensure the safe and reliable delivery of natural gas to customers between Steeles Avenue and Lancashire Lane.

TIMING

- Work is scheduled to start in mid-September, 2020 and will last approximately seven weeks.
- Work will occur between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Lane reductions will be required on Hurontario Street between Lancashire Lane and Steeles Avenue.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- At a minimum, one north and southbound lane will be maintained at all times.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Access to properties will always be maintained through at least one driveway.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- MiWay, Züm, and Brampton Transit will continue to operate with regular service.

- Due to lane reductions along Hurontario Street, delays can be expected on Brampton Transit routes 2, 54, 56, Züm route 502 and MiWay express route 103.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas will be relocated.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk access in the area could be affected.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

PROPERTY DETAILS

- Please ensure any personal belongings, such as signs, benches and underground sprinklers on city owned land have been relocated prior to the beginning of construction.
- For details on your property boundaries, please refer to your land survey, or consult an Ontario Land Surveyor.
