## HURONTARIO LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT

Information as of April, 2020

### Enbridge Gas Line Relocation on Hurontario Street from Hampshire Crescent to Inglewood Drive

Beginning Early May 2020

#### What is the Hurontario Light Rail Transit Project?

The Hurontario LRT will be an 18-kilometre, 19 stop light rail service connecting people from the Port Credit GO station to the Brampton Gateway Terminal. The Hurontario LRT will connect with the Port Credit and Cooksville GO stations, Mississauga Transitway, MiWay and Züm transit lines.

#### What work is taking place?

To accommodate the construction of the Hurontario LRT, Enbridge Gas is required to relocate a gas line on **Hurontario Street** from **Hampshire Crescent** to **Inglewood Drive**. These pipelines are integral to Enbridge's gas system and must be re-routed to ensure the safe and reliable delivery of natural gas to customers in the Greater Toronto Area.

#### Timing

- Work is scheduled to start in early May, 2020 and will last approximately seven months.
- Work will occur between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

#### What to Expect

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Access to properties will be maintained at all times through at least one driveway.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

#### Traffic Details

- Lane reductions will be required on Hurontario Street between Hampshire Crescent and Inglewood Drive.
- Traffic delays are expected.



**Note: at no time will all lanes be closed.**

### **Transit Details**

- Due to lane reductions along Hurontario Street, delays can be expected on MiWay Routes 17, 103 and 4.

### **Pedestrian Details**

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas. Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Sidewalk access in the area could be affected. Please watch for signage directing pedestrian traffic.

### **Property Details**

- Please ensure any personal belongings, such as signs, benches and underground sprinklers on city owned land have been relocated prior to the beginning of construction.
- For details on your property boundaries, please refer to your land survey, or consult an Ontario Land Surveyor.
