

# TRANSFORMING TRANSIT IN YOUR AREA

Overnight Investigative Work – Danforth GO Station

## New Track

150 kilometres of new dedicated GO track will allow for more uninterrupted service.



## New Trains

New electric trains will travel faster for longer and reduce travel times.



## New Bridges and Tunnels

Bridges and tunnels that eliminate intersections with rail and road traffic will provide more reliable GO train service.



## New Renovations

New and improved stations will make your journey more comfortable, from start to finish.

## THE LOCAL PROJECT

Metrolinx has begun a multi-year construction program to expand and improve the existing GO Transit service network. Increasing GO service in both directions means adding a new fourth track and expanding infrastructure, followed by electrifying parts of the network. This geo-technical study requires the drilling of boreholes and testing soil conditions. Boreholes will be drilled within the rail corridor and beside the rail corridor. Some of the borehole work will be completed at night due to heavy rail traffic operating during the daytime.

**When:** The borehole work will be completed throughout December as follows:

- December 3-7: Daytime drilling (8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.)
- December 10: Daytime drilling (8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.)
- December 12-13: Night time drilling (10:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m.)
- December 16-20: Night time drilling (10:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m.)
- December 23: Night time drilling (10:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m.)

These dates are subject to work force and site conditions. Contingency dates are added in case of delays. Contingency dates include: January 2-13, 2019, night time drilling (10:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m.).

**Additional details:** The work will take place at Danforth GO Station. This work will consist of construction noise generated from a drill rig, a generator and from trucks moving and beeping. We recognize that this work can be disruptive to nearby residents. The work crew will work to mitigate any noise and vibration where possible.
