



# TRANSFORMING TRANSIT IN YOUR AREA

## Upcoming Night Work (Between Queen Street East Rail Bridge to Kennedy Road Rail Bridge)

Metrolinx, an agency of the Province of Ontario, is working to transform the way the region moves by building a seamless, convenient and integrated transit network across the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA). Over the next ten years, Metrolinx is transforming the existing GO rail system to deliver a whole new rapid transit experience to your community. With more frequent train service you'll have more options to get you where you need to go.

### THE LOCAL PROJECT

Metrolinx has begun a multi-year construction program to expand and improve the existing GO Transit service network. As part of the work being undertaken by Metrolinx in 2018, night work involving thermite welding has been identified to proceed on **Friday July 27, 2018**.

**Work:** Work involves a small crew of workers, high rail vehicle, lighting.

**Date:** July 27

**Time:** Night Work, 11:00pm - 5:00am

**Locations:**

- work starts near Kennedy Road Rail Bridge and moves west along the rail corridor ending at Queen Street East Rail Bridge

### WHAT TO EXPECT

This work will consist of construction noise such as heavy equipment moving. We recognize that this work can be disruptive to the community and construction crews will do their best to mitigate any noise and vibration where possible.
