

Enbridge Gas Meter Relocation Work

December 2020



What is Happening?

From December 7 - December 18, 2020 Enbridge contractors are planning to relocate a gas meter at Little York Road. These dates are subject to weather delays. Updates will be provided in the Toronto East e-newsletter. See reverse to be added as a subscriber.

What to Expect?

Residents can expect to see construction vehicles and equipment within the project area, including hydro vacuum trucks, pick-up trucks, cube vans, dump trucks, mini-excavator. There will be some vegetation removal at the start of the project. One lane of Little York Road will be closed during the daytime for material laydown. Residential driveways will remain accessible. The roadway will be clear at the end of each workday. Traffic cones will separate the work area (shown in map) from vehicles, pedestrians. Signs and traffic control personnel will be on site to guide through traffic. Due to the nature of this work noise, vibration, dust can be anticipated.

HOURS OF WORK

- 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. (Monday through Friday).
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Traffic control measures will be in place
- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No impacts to TTC, or other public transit modes are anticipated during this work.
