


Updated: Fibre Optic Cable Relocation Work

Fall 2020 - Spring 2021



What is Happening?

In support of the GO Expansion Program - Early Works Project, fibre optic utility relocation works are currently ongoing within the Lakeshore East rail corridor, between Kennedy Road and Pape Avenue. The civil construction portion of the work includes drilling, trenching and the installation of manholes and handwells; the civil works are anticipated to be completed in winter 2021. After the completion of the civil works, fibre optic cables will be run in to the newly installed conduits and network cutovers will be completed. This project is anticipated to be completed in spring 2021.

What to Expect?

Residents can expect to see construction vehicles (hydro vacuum trucks, pick-up trucks, dump trucks), equipment (excavators, drill rig, reclaimer), reel trailers and conduit reels within the project limits. There are two (2) *primary* access locations for this work: Norwood Terrace/Kildonan Park on the south side of the corridor and the Wildwood Crescent lot, adjacent to the Wildwood Crescent Playground. The Wildwood lot location will continue to be used as a construction laydown area.

HOURS OF WORK

- 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m., six (6) days per week (Monday through Saturday).
- Occasional night work may be required.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Minimal traffic impacts are anticipated with this work; increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area(s).
- No pedestrian impacts are anticipated with this work.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No impacts to TTC, or other public transit modes are anticipated during this work.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Crews will endeavor to minimize construction related impacts whenever possible.
- Due to the nature of this work noise, vibration, dust and site lighting can be expected throughout this project.
- Some tree and vegetation clearing within the Metrolinx Right of Way will be required.
- In addition to the primary access locations noted above, crews will be accessing the rail corridor from various locations, within the project limits.
