


Lakeshore East (West) - Early Works

We want to hear from you on Metrolinx Engage



Project Overview

- Preparatory works to enable the future addition of a fourth track on the Lakeshore East Corridor are getting underway.
- The fourth track will contribute to passenger journey time improvements for all transit trips on the Lakeshore East Corridor, improve service reliability and deliver increased service benefits within the City of Toronto.
- The preparatory works that are required include: utility relocation, construction of retaining walls, storm water management infrastructure, bridge widening and rehabilitation at Woodbine, Warden and Danforth bridges and construction of a new culvert.

Project Location

- The GO Expansion, Early Works Project is starting in early Winter 2021 and will take place along the Lakeshore East rail corridor, between Pape Avenue and Kennedy Road.

Infrastructure Required: Retaining Walls

- Retaining walls come in a variety of formats.
- Along the Lakeshore East corridor, the type of retaining structure needed is known as a T-Wall.
- These walls do not require piling for installation and will not go above the height of the rail corridor.
- The walls are made of precast concrete, in a T shape and assist with stabilizing the slopes on either side of the rail corridor.

Help Us Decide

- The retaining walls will be composed of pre-cast, concrete liners. There are two (2) façade options (see page 1) available for the pre-cast concrete liners that will be installed at the *public facing* retaining wall areas along the Lakeshore East (west) corridor, and we want to hear your input to decide which option to move forward with!
- The public facing retaining walls will be located between Kennedy Rd to Milne Ave, Kimridge Ave, Smalls Creek to Bastedo Ave and east of Jones and Eagan Avenue(s). All five *public facing* retaining wall locations will have the same façade.
- When you have a say, our transportation system gets stronger - that's what Metrolinx Engage is all about. Metrolinx Engage provides an *online* platform for keeping our communities updated and to provide feedback opportunities.
- You will have an opportunity to ask questions, provide feedback and indicate your preference between the two (2) façade options on Metrolinx Engage from **November 20th - December 4th, 2020**.
- Metrolinx will advise on the outcome of the consultation via our weekly Toronto East e-newsletter.
- All feedback will be gathered, and a final decision will be made based on public input.
