Lakeshore East GO Expansion

Today, if you live in Oshawa, Toronto, or anywhere in between, you enjoy two-way, all-day service seven days a week. We're going to take it up a notch. With GO expansion on the Lakeshore East line, we're bringing 15-minute two-way service between Union Station and Oshawa. Faster, more frequent travel is coming your way. Forget the car - welcome to your future.

What Work is Taking Place?

- Beginning in late-July, overnight fibre optic cable relocation work will occur within the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor between Kennedy Road and Pape Avenue
- Initial utility work will be done sequentially along the 9km stretch, lasting 3-4 nights at each location
- Crews will then return to each location for a longer duration to install new cables
- More details will be communicated as this work progresses

Hours of Work

- Work hours will be **overnight**, between 10:00 p.m. - 5:30 a.m, Monday through Saturday
- Beginning late-July for 4-6 months
- In order to minimize disruption to those living close to the rail corridor, it is our goal to complete some work during the day, however most work will be conducted overnight

What to Expect

- The work consists of directional drilling and some excavation
- Night lighting directed at the rail corridor can be expected
- There will be some level of noise during the overnight period from generators, air compressors and some truck activity, including the use of a vacuum truck
- Equipment and work crew will enter the corridor at an access location
