

Level Crossing Improvements: Anti Trespass Mat Installation

July 6, 2020 Rodd Avenue

Safety is central to the reliability of our services at Metrolinx. This summer you may notice construction in your community as we work to improve safety at eight level crossings along the Lakeshore East corridor. We will be installing anti-trespass panels at every level crossing on the corridor, making it difficult for pedestrians to enter the right-of-way. The panels surround the tracks and feature a round cone-shaped pattern on top.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU

While this work is underway at your crossing residents may notice maintenance crews and machinery in the corridor for about a week. We do our best to complete track maintenance during the day, but work on this project will need to proceed overnight while rail traffic is lightest. Residents may notice noise from the machinery and some ambient light from the site. The use of back-up beepers, a vital safety measure, will be limited to essential work only.
