



# TRANSFORMING TRANSIT IN YOUR AREA

## Temporary Road Closure at Main Street in Stouffville – Weekend of September 14

Metrolinx, an agency of the Province of Ontario, is working to transform the way the region moves by building a seamless, convenient and integrated transit network across the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA). Over the next ten years, Metrolinx is transforming the existing GO rail system to deliver a whole new rapid transit experience to your community. With more frequent train service you'll have more options to get you where you need to go.

### THE LOCAL PROJECT

As part of the crossing improvement work being undertaken by Metrolinx in 2018, the Main Street railway crossing on Main Street between Blake Street and Edward Street has been identified for work this week. Vehicle traffic for Edward Street will remain available.

The work is scheduled to take place on the weekend of September 14, starting at 10:00 pm Friday September 14, and completed by 5:00am on the morning of September 17.

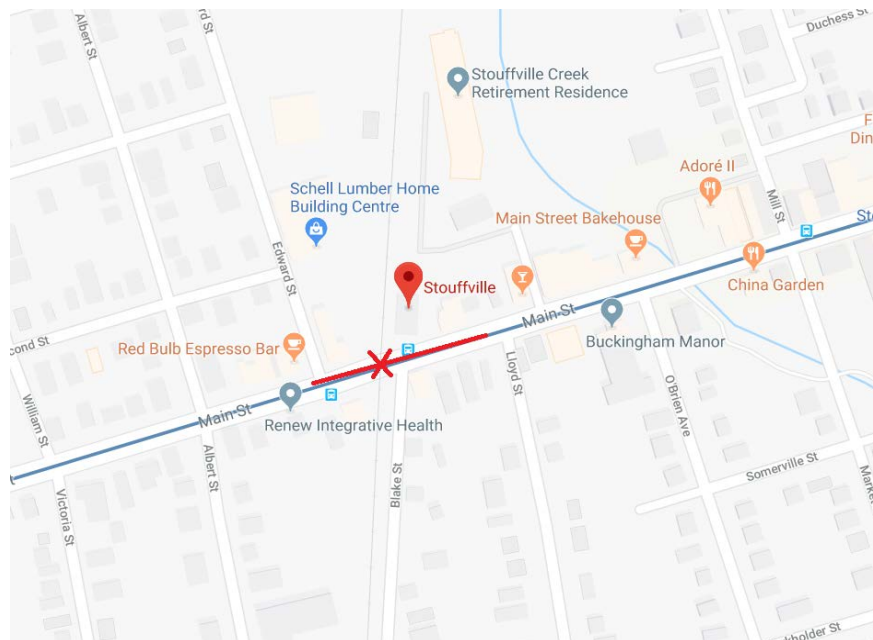
This work will help improve and update the railway crossing for continued daily use. The work is expected to be only confined to this particular weekend.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

During this time, Main Street will be closed to all vehicle and pedestrian traffic at the crossing location only.

There will be moderate noise that will involve light drilling and excavating. A detour route with signs will be provided.
