Toronto East Region GO Expansion Project: Stouffville Steeles Avenue East Weekend Closure & Temporary Detour Road (Between Redlea Avenue and Old Kennedy Road/Silver Star Boulevard) Timing: Starting May 29, 2020

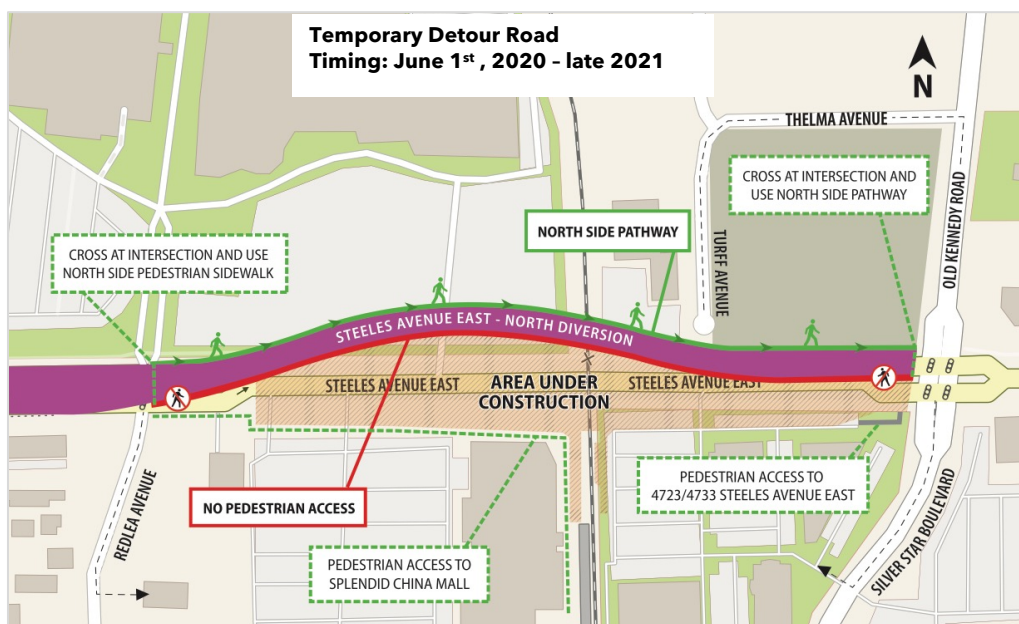
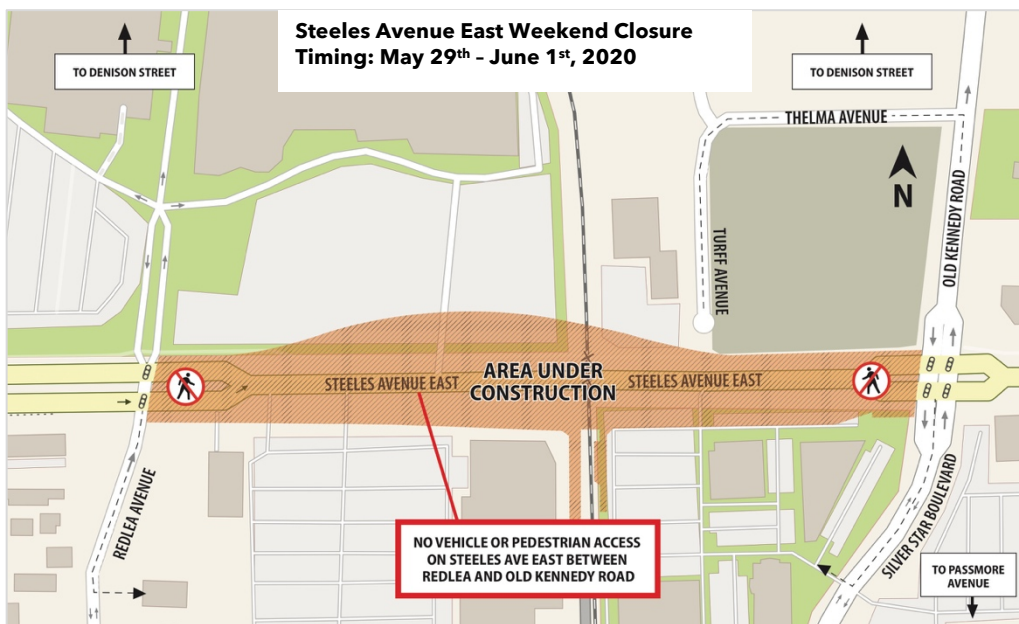
Metrolinx is working to transform the way the region moves by building a seamless, convenient and integrated transit network across the Greater Golden Horseshoe Area. Metrolinx is transforming the existing GO rail system to deliver a whole new rapid transit experience to your community. With more frequent train service you'll have more options to get you where you need to go.

WHAT IS THE STOUFFVILLE STATIONS PROJECT?

Metrolinx is making major infrastructure improvements to the Agincourt, Milliken, and Unionville GO stations. This work includes the construction of new grade-separated rail and pedestrian bridges at the existing Steeles Avenue East at-grade rail crossing between Kennedy Road and Midland Avenue, which also includes a new road underpass on Steeles Avenue East below the railway corridor.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- There will be a full closure of Steeles Avenue East between Redlea and Old Kennedy/Silver Star Boulevard to prepare for the temporary detour road.
- The closure will start on Friday, May 29th (8 p.m.) until Monday, June 1st (6 a.m.)
- Please watch for road signs directing you to alternate routes.
- On June 1st, we will shift traffic to the temporary detour road north of Steeles Avenue East between Redlea Avenue and Silver Star Boulevard to divert traffic. The temporary detour road will be in place until late 2021.
- This work will allow crews to build the new underpass and pedestrian bridge at Steeles Avenue East while maintaining traffic flow.
- Two lanes of traffic in each direction will be maintained throughout the detour road and will provide access to Redlea Avenue and Silver Star Boulevard. Access to Turff Avenue is closed.
- Pedestrians will travel along Steeles (between Redlea and Silver Star) via a new, temporary pedestrian sidewalk on the north side of the detour road. Due to space restrictions during construction, there will be no pedestrian access on the south side of Steeles.
- Business access will remain available from Redlea Avenue and Silver Star Boulevard.
- You will notice more heavy equipment and cranes in the construction area.
- Drivers are asked to watch for traffic control personnel, obey posted speed limits at all times, and look out for signs directing drivers along the detour route.
