
Gas Line Relocation for Finch West Light Rail Transit

The Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT) is an 11km LRT running along Finch Ave. West between Keele St. and Humber College. The Finch West LRT will replace 35 peak period buses, increasing capacity and reliability of service along the route, and significantly reducing travel times for transit users on the corridor.

What work is taking place?

What: As part of the preparatory work for the project, Enbridge Gas Distribution (Enbridge) will begin phase one of relocating natural gas pipelines along the Finch West LRT route.

Why: To accommodate the construction of the new Finch West LRT, Enbridge is required to relocate natural gas pipelines from the centre of the roadway (the proposed location of the new track-bed) to the south side of Finch Ave. West.



When: Starting late March 2017, crews will begin to occupy a section of the roadway on Finch Ave. West between Kipling Ave. and Islington Ave. The work will take place on the south side of Finch Ave. West as crews dig and install the relocated natural gas pipeline. It is expected that the work will take approximately three months to complete and will affect traffic in both directions on Finch Ave. West. Some work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions and any unforeseen circumstances.

Where: Phase 1 will begin at the intersection of Kipling Ave. and Finch Ave. West, and will span approximately 400m east towards Islington Ave.



Transit Information

For the safety of transit riders, TTC bus stops in the affected area will be relocated as required. Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians.

Pedestrian and Traffic Details

During construction hours, lane reductions or short-term road closures may be required. These roads will be reopened in the evening for local residents. Driveways will be accessible to residents at all times.

Please take care when travelling near construction areas. Pedestrian walkways will remain open but we ask that you watch for additional signs directing pedestrians, as detours may be required.

Due to the current volume of traffic in this area, traffic delays are expected during construction.

Work Hours

Most of the work will be carried out between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday. In certain situations, some late night and/or early morning and/or Sunday work may be required. The Enbridge contractor will not always work during the extended hours, but may do so at their discretion.
