Environmental Project Report (EPR) Addendum - Barrie Rail Corridor Expansion Project

Metrolinx and Regional Express Rail

Metrolinx, an agency of the Government of Ontario, is working to bring more transit connections to communities within the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA) through the Regional Express Rail (RER) program. RER is Metrolinx's 10-year program to bring more and better train service to customers on the GO network. As part of RER, Metrolinx is planning to build the proposed Kirby GO Station in your community. In April, we will be hosting a public meeting to provide information about the proposed Kirby GO Station and to get your feedback.

The Project

Metrolinx is completing an Addendum to the Barrie Rail Corridor Expansion Project Environmental Project Report (EPR) in accordance with the Transit Project Assessment Process set out in *Ontario Regulation 231/08: Transit Projects and Metrolinx Undertakings* to include five proposed stations along the Barrie rail corridor, including Kirby GO Station. The purpose of the EPR Addendum is to evaluate the potential environmental impacts of these proposed new stations, and to propose mitigation measures to avoid or minimize effects. The proposed Kirby GO Station will be located on the Barrie rail corridor south of Kirby Road and west of Keele Street in the City of Vaughan, as shown in the figure below.

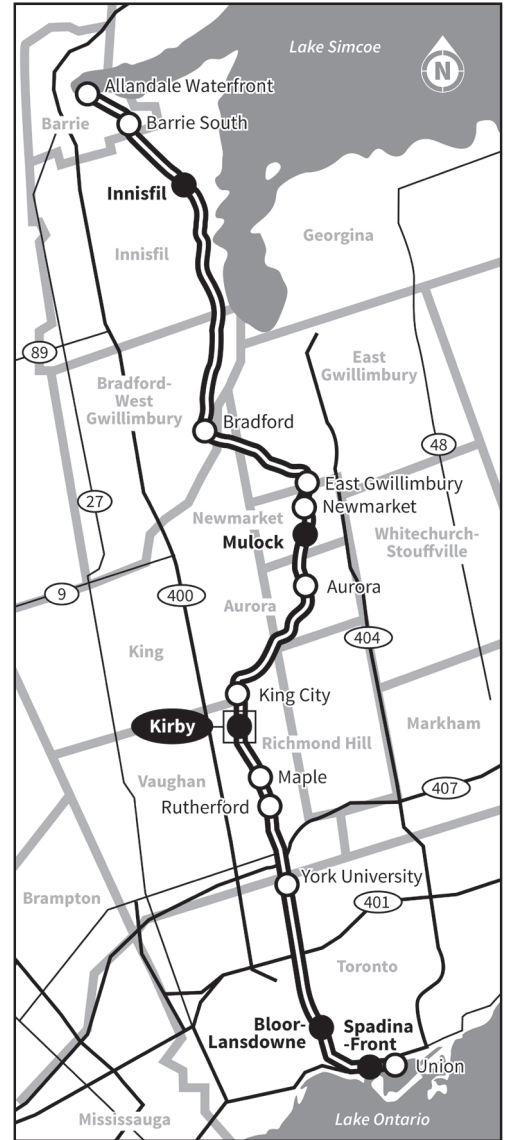
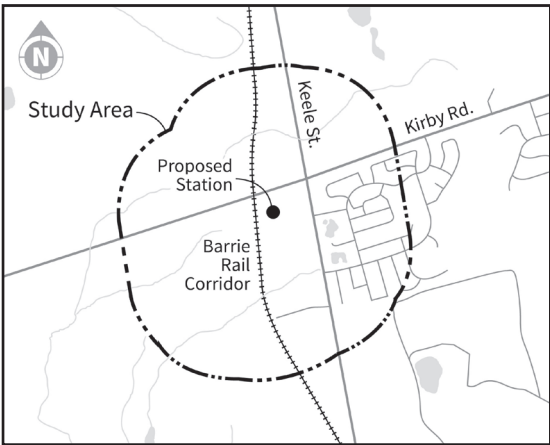
