

TRANSFORMING TRANSIT IN YOUR AREA

Desjardin Canal New Bridge Span Installation

November 2016

THE PROJECT

Metrolinx, an agency of the Province of Ontario, is working to transform the way the region moves by building a seamless, convenient and integrated transit network across the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA). Over the next ten years, Metrolinx is transforming the existing GO rail system to deliver a whole new rapid transit experience to your community. With frequent two-way, all-day train service 7 days a week; you'll have more options to get you where you need to go.

THE LOCAL PROJECT

On November 28th, 2016 beginning at 9:00 a.m. the Canadian National Railway (CNR) will install a new bridge span at the Desjardin Canal. This new span will carry a future third track which will allow for additional operational flexibility between Hamilton and Aldershot.

WHAT TO EXPECT

The work will result in the closure of the Waterfront Trail directly underneath the bridge. Detour and bridge closure signs will be visible at the Desjardins Recreation Trail and Waterfront Trail entrances to notify users of the temporary closure.

TIMING

The work will start at on Monday, November 28, 2016 and will end Friday, December 2nd.

Hours of work are expected to be Monday to Friday: 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Metrolinx is committed to keeping local residents and businesses informed about construction activities and minimizing potential disruptions related to this work.
