Re: PARK LAWN GO STATION

We are writing on behalf of iloft - TSCC 2153 (155 Legion Road North) and California Condos - TSCC 2289 (165 Legion Road North), representing 626 condominium unit owners and approximately 1,500 residents.

The decision by Metrolinx to remove the Park Lawn Road GO station from the GO Regional Express Rail Plan has a significant negative impact on our residents, along with the thousands of other residents of Mystic Point, Humber Bay Shores and south Mimico.

Traffic congestion has increased exponentially in recent months, and will continue with the completion of new condominiums on Lakeshore Boulevard and Manitoba Street. In particular, access between the Queen Elizabeth Way and Lakeshore Boulevard West via Park Lawn Road poses major gridlock during rush hours. The Park Lawn GO station would reduce commuter vehicle traffic and ease this congestion.

We support the appeal to re-instate the Park Lawn GO Station in the GO Regional Express Rail Expansion Plan.
