

Geotechnical Investigative Work

Spring 2021



What is Happening?

Along the Canadian Pacific (CP) owned rail corridor there will be geotechnical investigative work ongoing until Summer 2021. The purpose of this work is to collect important information for the future Bowmanville Expansion Project between Oshawa GO Station and Bowmanville Avenue in Bowmanville.

What to Expect

Geotechnical work requires the drilling of boreholes and testing soil conditions which is required before the future construction of corridor infrastructure. Residents can expect to see a small drill rig, trucks, and a crew working within, or near the rail corridor. Due to the nature of this work noise, vibrations and dust can be expected.



HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur between the hours of 7:00 am and 5:00 pm, five (5) days per week (Monday to Friday).
- Additional work may be required during the evening hours or on weekends. Advanced notice will be provided through our regional e-newsletter.
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Minimal traffic impacts are anticipated with this work. Where traffic impacts are expected, traffic control arrangements will be made where required.
- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- No pedestrian impacts are anticipated with this work.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No impacts to Durham Region Transit (DRT) or other public transit modes are anticipated during this work.
