

# Topographic Survey Work

Winter 2021/2022



## What is Happening?

Beginning in December 2021 until March 2022 there will be topographic survey work conducted at properties near the Canadian Pacific (CP) rail corridor between Thornton Road South (Oshawa) and Bowmanville Avenue (Bowmanville).

This important work is required to support the preliminary design activities for the Bowmanville Expansion project and is anticipated to take approximately three months to complete.

## What to Expect?

Residents can expect to see survey a small crew working within, or near the CP rail corridor. This work will be non-invasive and is not expected to generate a significant amount of noise, vibration, or dust.

Crews may require access to private property to complete this work.



## HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur between the hours of 7:00 am and 5:00 pm, five (5) days per week (Monday to Friday).
- Additional work may be required during the evening hours or on weekends. Advanced notice will be provided through our Durham regional e-newsletter.
- Work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

## TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Minimal traffic impacts are anticipated with this work. Where traffic impacts are expected, traffic control measures will be implemented.
- No pedestrian impacts are anticipated with this work.

## TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No impacts to Durham Region Transit (DRT) or other public transit modes are anticipated during this work.
