


Bloor Street West: Partial Road and Sidewalk Closures for Bridge Work - South Side

May 18 to 24, 2021



What work is taking place?

To support the new Bloor Street bridge, we need to demolish and rebuild the existing concrete bridge ends (known as abutments) on which the bridge rests. But first, we need to install structural caissons that will form the foundation of the new bridge abutments. A partial road and sidewalk closure is required to carry out the concrete pours for the structural caissons on the south side of the bridge.

When

The partial closures will take place over two non-consecutive days between May 18-24.

Where

Partial closure will be in place between St. Helens Ave and Ruttan St, on the south side of Bloor St W. Concrete pours will be carried out from street level at the GO rail bridge.

Hours

Between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.

What to expect

Local residents and the surrounding community can expect a few things:

- South lanes and sidewalk of Bloor St W between St. Helens Ave and Ruttan St will be closed.
- North lanes and sidewalk of Bloor St W will remain open, with one traffic lane in each direction.
- Motorists and cyclists will share the lane.
- Potential traffic delays and congestion, especially at peak hours.
- Construction activity and noise.
