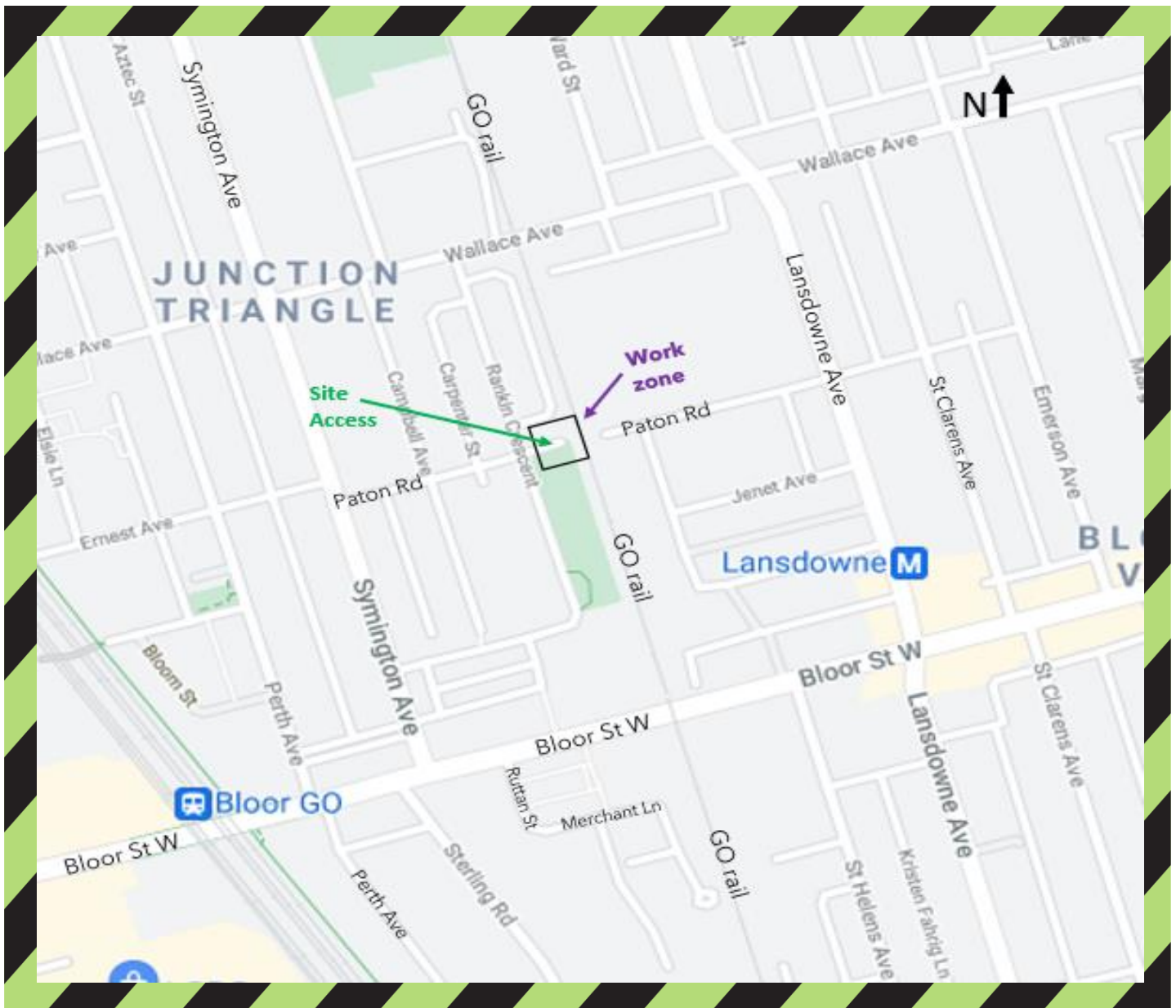


Paton Road Pedestrian Underpass Caisson Drilling

Early-June to July 2021



What work is taking place?

The Paton Road pedestrian underpass is part of the Davenport Diamond Guideway project, connecting the east and west sides of Paton Road that are currently cut off by the GO rail tracks. To support the construction of the underpass, crews will be drilling caissons at Paton Road.

Caisson drilling involves drilling a hole into the ground down to more supportive bedrock, lifting in steel rebar cage reinforcement, and then pouring concrete. This creates reinforced concrete columns underground that will support the load of the tunnel structure and trains above.

When

June and July 2021.

Work will be carried out Monday through Friday.

Where

At Paton Road within the rail corridor.

Hours

Approximately 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

**Please note that dates and times are approximate, and work could be rescheduled.*

What to expect

Nearby residents can expect noise and increased construction activity on the west side of Paton Road.

The gravel area on the west side of Paton Road, just outside of the rail corridor at the gates, will be used as a staging area to park concrete trucks.
