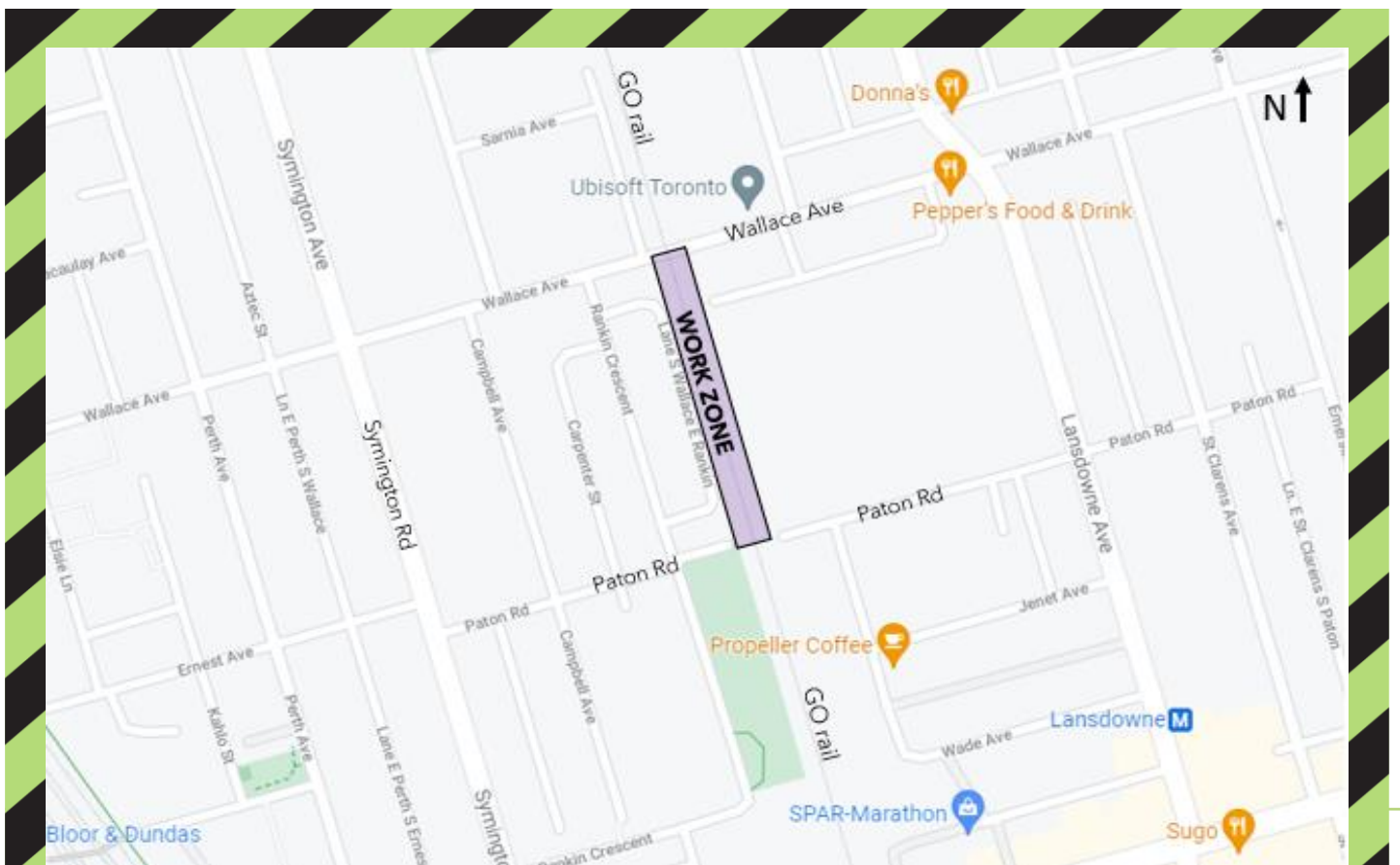


Paton Road to Wallace Avenue Grading, Drainage Installation and Monitoring Well Relocation - Overnight Work

November 1-5, 2021 (five nights)

What work is taking place?

Crews will be working overnight for one week between Paton Road and Wallace Avenue in preparation for mechanically stabilized earth wall (i.e., MSE wall) construction. Crews will be grading and installing drainage, as well as relocating a monitoring well that currently sits in the way of MSE wall construction.

When

Monday, November 1 to Friday, November 5 (five nights).

Where

Within the rail corridor between Paton Road and Wallace Avenue.

Hours

Approximately 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

What to expect

Local residents can expect construction activity, noise, mild vibration, and lights. Crews will be using the following equipment to carry out this work: excavator, bulldozer, loader, drum roller, small drill, and generator.

Why overnight?

The grading, drainage installation, and monitoring well relocation are all taking place adjacent to the track. Therefore, these activities must be performed overnight when trains are not running to protect the track and the workers.
