

Short Term Sidewalk Closures on Bloor Street West for Scaffolding Installation

June 11, 2021



What work is taking place?

We are installing scaffolding over the north and south sidewalks. Scaffolding will span from centerline of bridge to west right-of-way on both sidewalks for about 10 metres. Scaffolding is being installed to protect the public from any construction debris during excavation behind the north and south bridge abutments (concrete structures at the two ends of the bridge that support the bridge deck). Scaffolding is expected to remain in place for about a month and a half while crews carry out the excavation.

When

Friday, June 11.

Where

Under and 10 metres to the west of the Bloor Street West rail bridge between Lansdowne Avenue and Symington Avenue.

Hours

6 a.m. to 6 p.m.

What to expect

Local residents and the surrounding community can expect a few things:

- Short term sidewalk closures on Bloor Street West between St. Helens Avenue and Ruttan Street while crews install scaffolding.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained with one sidewalk open at all times during scaffolding installation.
- Signage will be in place.
- Road will remain open in both directions the entire time.
- Minor construction activity while crews install scaffolding.
