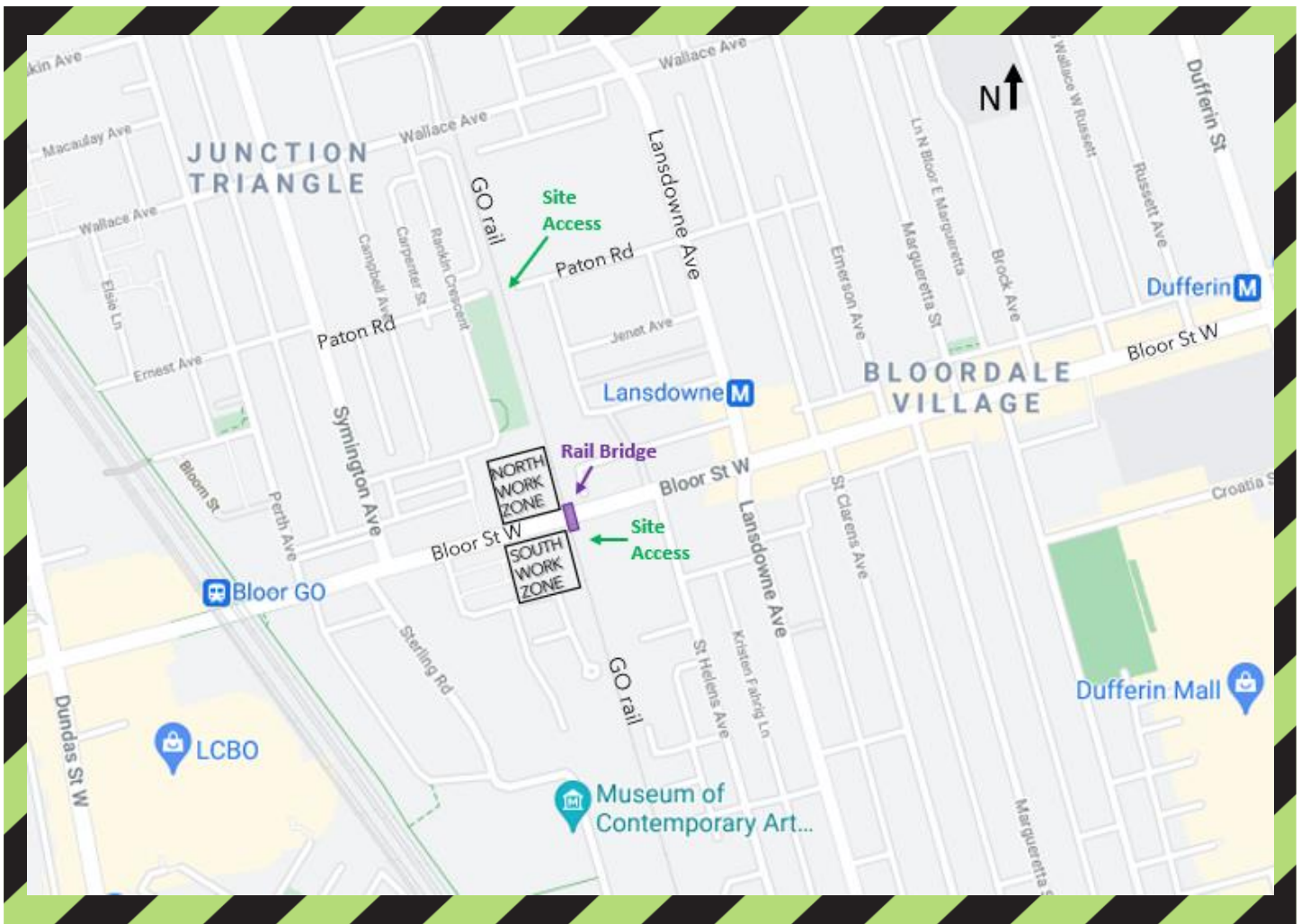


Bloor Street West: Excavation Behind the North and South Bridge Abutments

Early-June to July 2021



What work is taking place?

To support the new Bloor Street bridge, we need to demolish and rebuild the existing concrete bridge ends (known as abutments) on which the bridge rests. But before demolition can begin, we need to excavate behind the existing abutments and install bracing around the shoring piles we installed earlier this year. We will be working at both ends of the bridge simultaneously, with the north side starting a bit sooner than the south.

When

This work will take place from early-June to July 2021.

Where

At the north and south ends of the Bloor Street West rail bridge between Lansdowne Avenue and Symington Avenue.

Hours

Most of the work will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Some weekend and night shifts will be required when crews are working very close to the existing track, as fewer to no trains run during these times.

What to expect

Local residents and the surrounding community can expect a few things:

- Construction activity and noise.
- Use of excavators and dump trucks.
- Temporary partial road and sidewalk closures of Bloor Street West (as needed).
- Occasional night and weekend work (community will be notified in advance of night work).
