


Gantry Crane Footing Installation at Dupont Street - Overnight Work

August 3 - 14, 2021



What work is taking place?

We are installing footings for the gantry crane that will be used to erect girders for the elevated guideway. A footing is a strong base for the gantry crane to sit on during girder erection. Footings ensure the stability of the gantry crane used to lift the concrete girders for the elevated guideway into place. At Dupont Street, the gantry crane spans the width of the entire rail corridor, including over the diversion track. The footings on the east side of the track are being installed overnight - immediately north and south of the bridge and again approximately 20 metres north and south of the bridge.

When

August 3 - 14 (approximately).

Where

North and south of the Dupont Street bridge on the east side of the track.

Hours

Approximately 6 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Why overnight work?

These gantry crane footings are being installed very close to the track. As such, the work must be done overnight when trains are not running to protect the track and the workers.

What to expect

Nearby residents can expect construction activity, moderate noise, and lights. Antler Street and Campbell Avenue will be used for worker and equipment access to the site. Equipment includes an excavator or backhoe that will install screw piles for the gantry crane footings.
