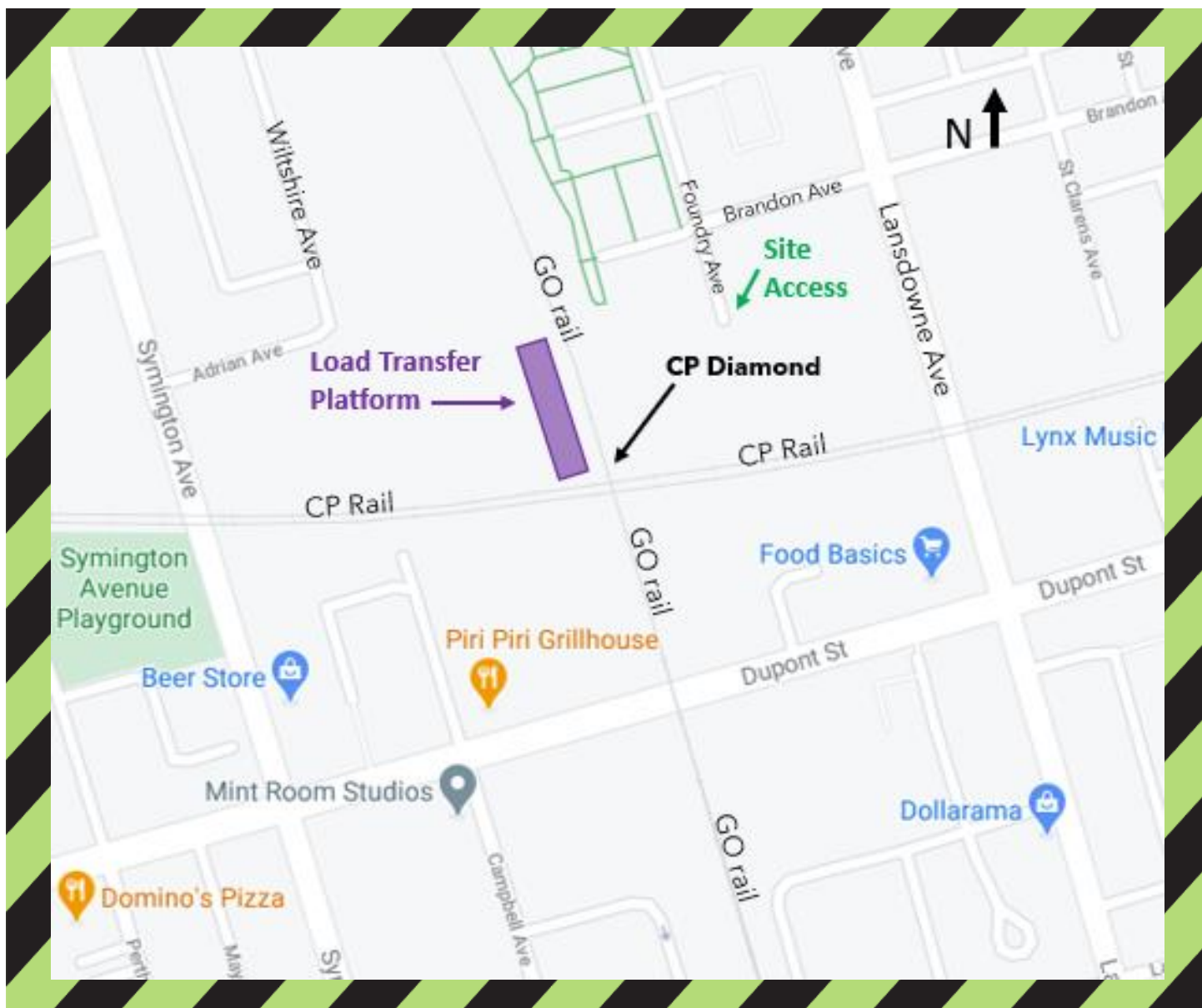


Overnight Work - Load Transfer Platform North of CP Diamond

July 12 to 16, 2021



What work is taking place?

We are building a load transfer platform just north of the CP Diamond. The platform consists of a gravel pad with layers of reinforcement and is part of the ground improvements in the area. The platform transfers the load of the MSE, that will be built over top, to the concrete columns drilled below.

When

Five nights: Monday, July 12 to Friday, July 16 (inclusive).

This work was rescheduled from: July 6 to 9.

Where

Just north of the CP Diamond.

Hours

6 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Why overnight work?

Sections of the load transfer platform are being built very close to the existing track, so the work must be done when trains are not running.

What to expect

Nearby residents can expect construction activity, noise, and lights. Foundry Avenue will be used for worker and equipment access to the site. Equipment includes excavator, smooth drum roller, dump trucks and pickup trucks.
