

Temporary Relocation of Accessible Parking Spot on Paton Road for Equipment Removal

September 27 to 29, 2021



What work is taking place?

The accessible parking spot on Paton Road just east of Symington Avenue needs to be temporarily relocated to facilitate construction equipment leaving the rail corridor via the Paton Road access gate. The existing accessible parking spot will be blocked off by cones and signs. A temporary accessible parking spot will be designated near the existing spot on either the north or south side of Paton Road with signs.

When

Monday, September 27 to Wednesday, September 29.

Where

On Paton Road just east of Symington Avenue.

Hours

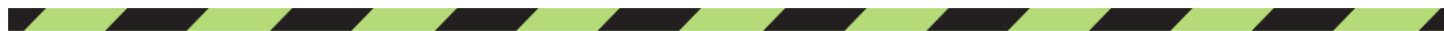
Continuously from Monday morning to Wednesday evening.

In addition to the temporary relocation of the accessible parking spot, nearby residents can expect to see and hear construction equipment leaving the rail corridor between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Nearby residents can expect increased activity on Paton Road between Symington Avenue and the rail corridor during this time.
