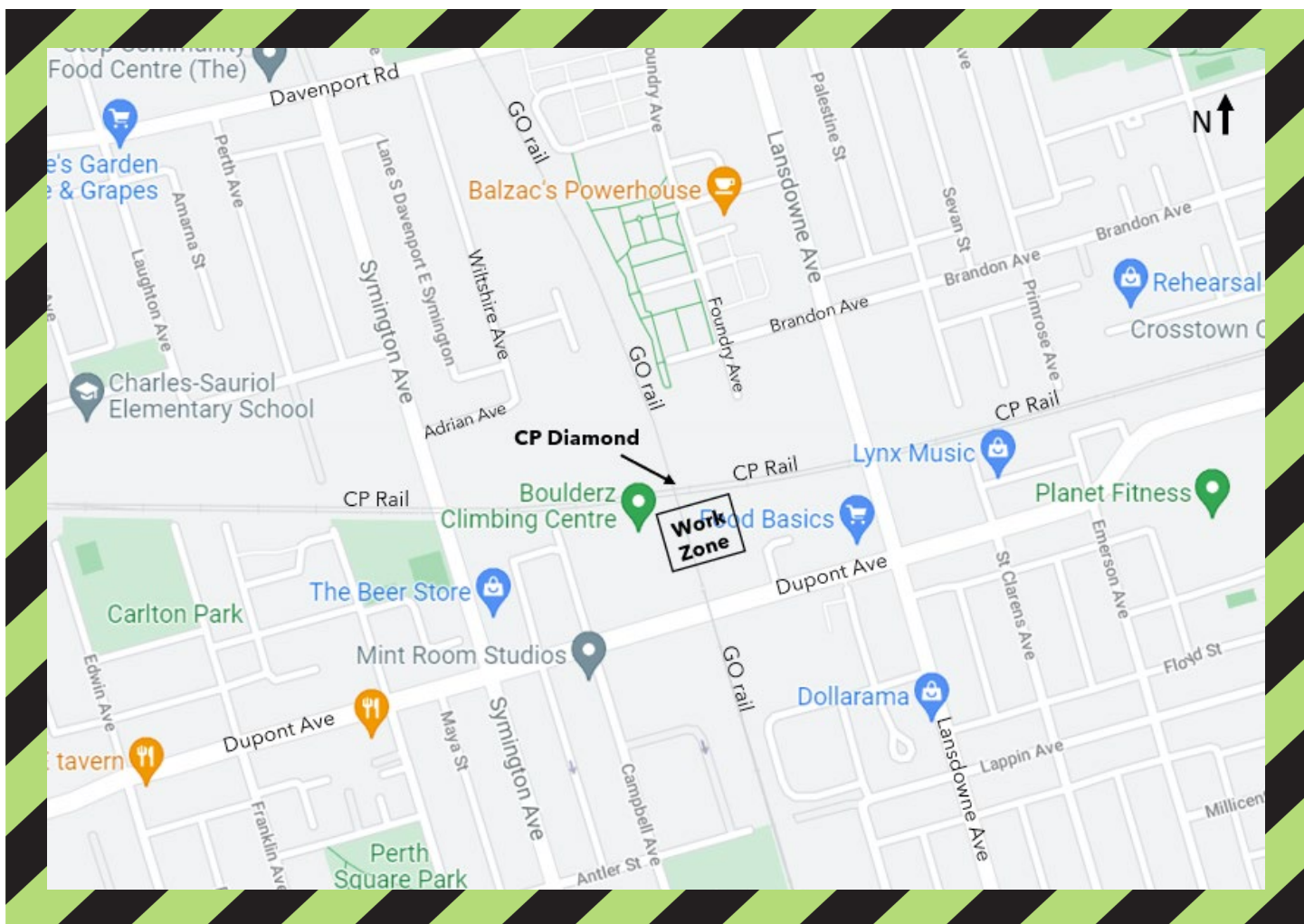


Track Crossing Installation near the CP Diamond - Overnight Work

October 20 to 22, 2021 (three nights)



What work is taking place?

We are installing a track crossing on the diversion track, just south of the CP Diamond. The track crossing is approximately 70 feet long and will be used in the near future to bring a crane from the west side of the rail corridor to the east side (crossing over the diversion track), where a crane pad will be installed. The crane will sit on the southeast corner of the CP Diamond and will be used to erect the steel girders for the new CP bridge.

When

October 20 to 22, inclusive (three nights).

Where

Just south of the CP Diamond (located north of Dupont Avenue).

Hours

From approximately 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

What to expect

Nearby residents can expect construction activity, noise, and lights. Some of the equipment that will be used includes a boom truck, tool truck, dump truck, etc.

Why overnight work?

As the track crossing is being installed on the diversion track, it must be done overnight when trains are not running to protect the workers and the track.
