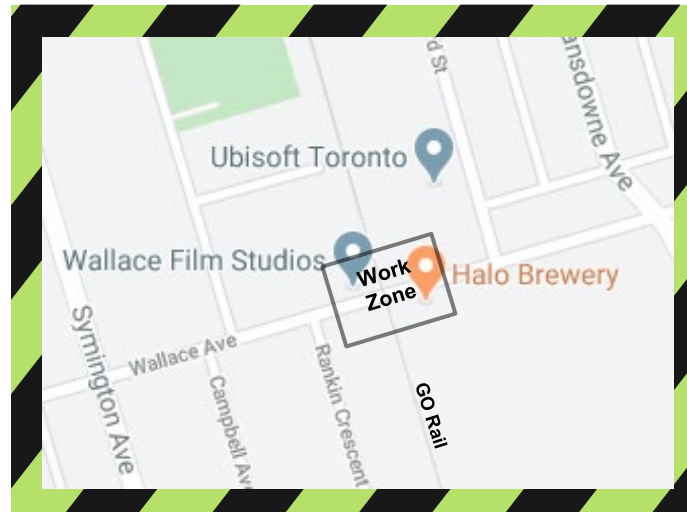


Notice for Wallace Avenue Signal Relocations

Late June - Early July 2020



What work is taking place?

As part of the construction of the Davenport Diamond Grade Separation Project, the constructor will be temporarily relocating the signal structures at Wallace Avenue and the GO tracks. These signal structures will be moved not far from their current locations to align with the temporary diversion track and allow for guideway construction.

WHEN

The work is scheduled to start in late June and last for approximately two weeks. Please note these dates are tentative, and work could be rescheduled.

WHERE

On Wallace Avenue, at the intersection of Wallace Avenue and the GO Rail tracks.

WORKING HOURS

This work is scheduled to take place daily from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. One overnight shift from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. is scheduled to take place in early July. Please note these dates are tentative and could be rescheduled.

***Update* Overnight: Friday, July 4 to Saturday, July 5. Work will begin at 6 p.m. on Friday and last until the late morning on Saturday.**

All work will be performed off the road on the sidewalk. Only one Wallace Avenue sidewalk will be closed at any time; one sidewalk will always remain open. Signage will be in place for pedestrians and cyclists. Road traffic will not be impacted by the work. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience, and we will make every effort to minimize disruption.
