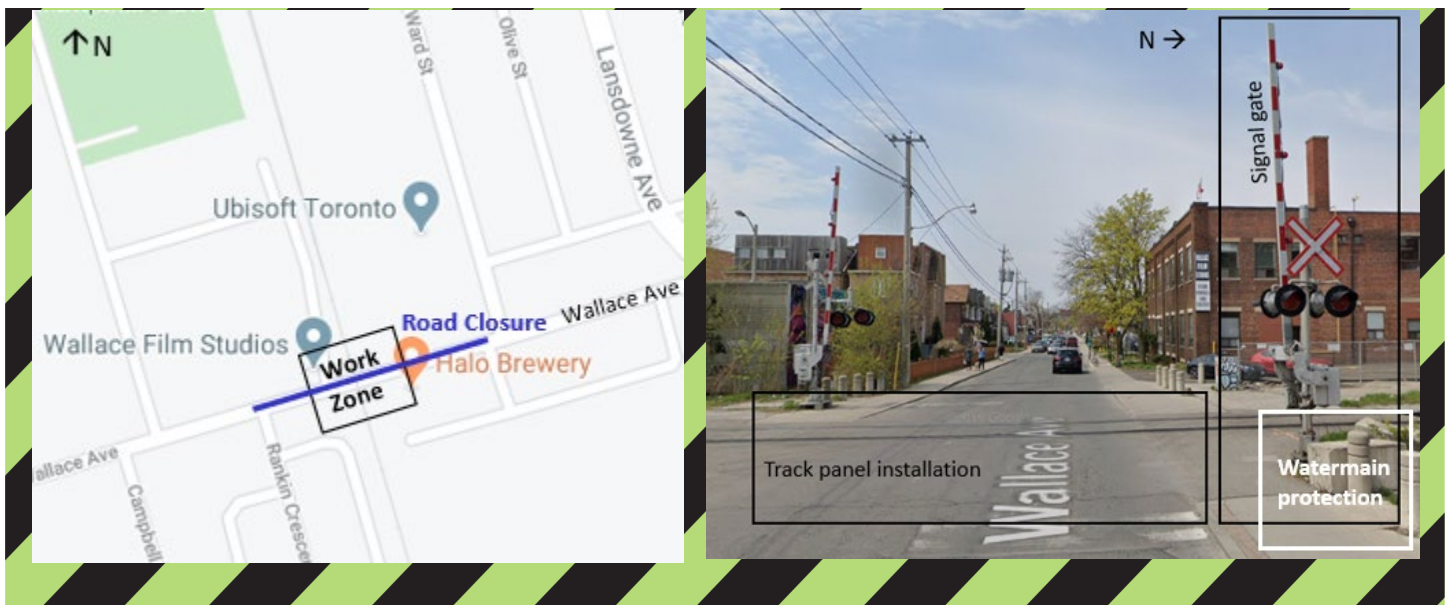


Wallace Avenue Signal Relocation, Watermain Protection and Track Panel Installation ***Update**

Late July to Early August



What work is taking place?

As part of the temporary diversion track construction, the constructor will be doing significant work at the Wallace Avenue / GO Rail crossing. Activities include: 1) relocating the northeast signal gate to align with the diversion track (**completed**); 2) installing a concrete protection slab across the watermain under the north sidewalk (**underway**); and 3) installing the rail track panel across Wallace Avenue (**upcoming**). Activities will occur in this order.

When

The work is scheduled to begin in late July and last for approximately two weeks. **Construction began on Saturday, July 25 and is expected to be completed by Sunday, August 9.**

*Please note these dates are tentative, and work could be rescheduled.

Where

At the intersection of Wallace Avenue and the GO Rail tracks.

Hours

This work will take place daily from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. including weekends. **One overnight shift is scheduled to take place from Friday, August 7 at 6 p.m. to Saturday, August 8 at 3 p.m.**

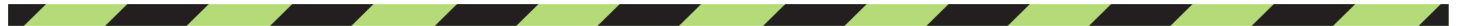
*Please note these dates and times are tentative, and work could be rescheduled.

What to expect

Work will be performed on the roadway and on the sidewalks. One Wallace Avenue sidewalk will always remain open.

A full closure of the Wallace Avenue roadway between Ward Street and Rankin Crescent is required and will take place overnight from Friday, August 7 at 6 p.m. to Saturday, August 8 at 3 p.m. Local traffic only during road closure; no through-traffic across the GO Rail tracks.

Signage will be in place for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists. Residents can expect bright lights at night, and increased noise from heavy rail equipment and operating machinery. **Residents can expect loud noise and vibration on Saturday, August 8 between 6 a.m. and 3 p.m.**
