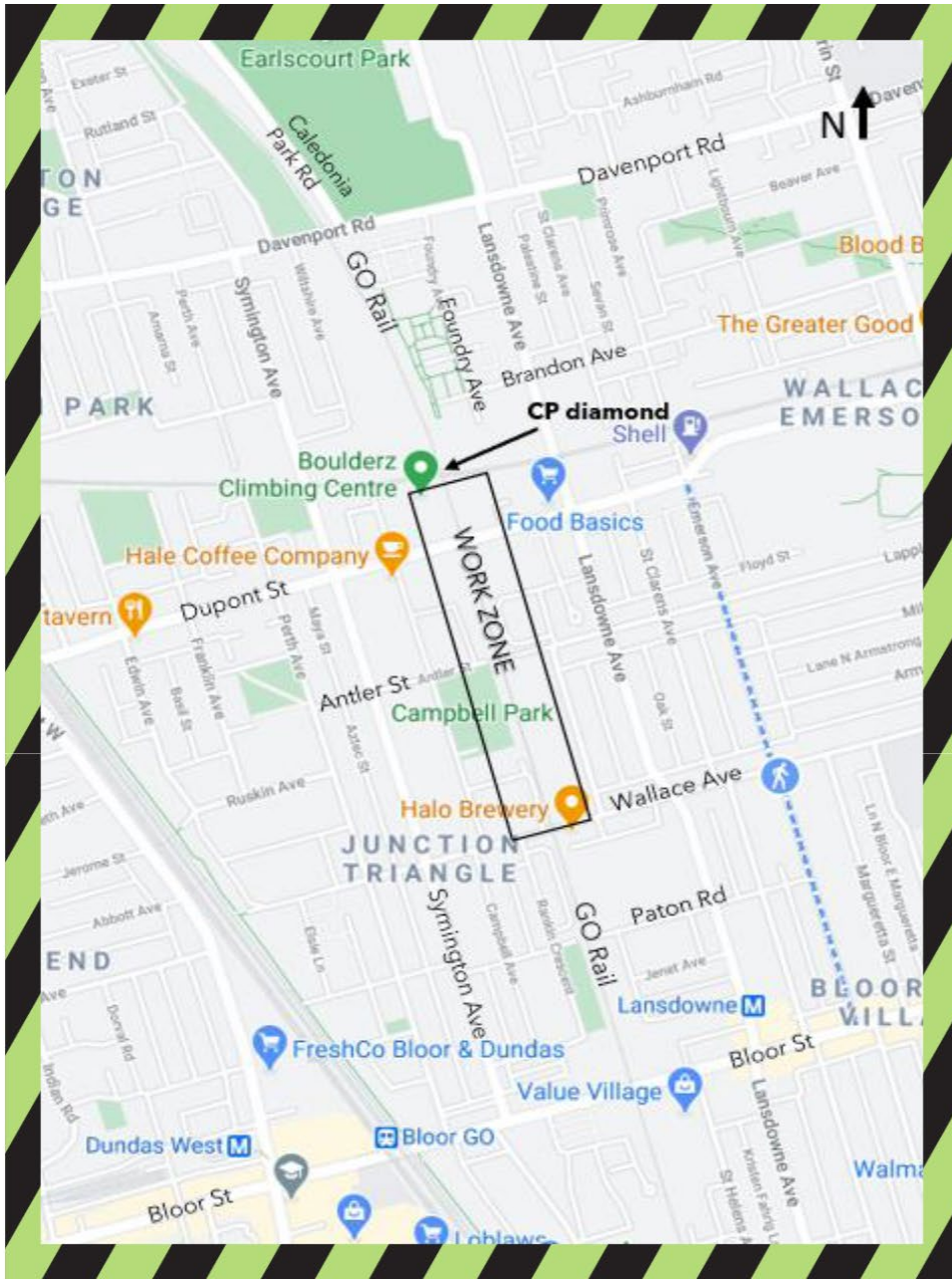


Rail Repair (Overnight Work)

November 4 to 5, 2020



What work is taking place?

The rail repair taking place is necessary follow-up work to rail maintenance that was completed over the past weekend. The work involves removing the section of rail that was temporarily repaired on the weekend and replacing it with new continuously welded rail to ensure continued safe use.

When

The work is scheduled to take place overnight on Wednesday, November 4 into Thursday, November 5.

Where

The work will take place within the rail corridor between Wallace Avenue and the CP diamond (just north of Dupont Street).

Hours

This work will take place overnight. Crews will begin at approximately 8 p.m. on Wednesday, November 4 and work into the early morning of Thursday, November 5.

What to expect

Residents can expect noise as crews remove rail spikes and anchors, cut and weld rail, and destress the rail to prevent thermal expansion. Crews will work diligently to complete this work as quickly and safely as possible.

This is emergency rail repair for safety reasons.

*Please note these dates are tentative, and work could be rescheduled.
