


## Tree Removals in the Scarlett Road Area

October 2022



### What work is happening here?

Specific private trees are being removed ahead of the extraction shaft construction for the Eglinton Crosstown West Extension Advanced Tunnel Project. The removal of three private property trees on the 1 Richview Road property, just north of the Eglinton Avenue West north sidewalk, is planned for the second week of October. Only trees conflicting with this construction work will be removed.

### What to Expect

Environmental personnel will be on site to ensure tree removal is carried out in accordance with regulatory requirements. Noise from construction activity can be expected.

### Hours of Work

Work to remove these trees will take place during daytime work hours during the week.

### Safety

To ensure safety, construction crews may temporarily close traffic lanes and sidewalks. Sufficient traffic signage and alternative walkways will be provided during the construction time.

## **Environmental Background**

West End Connectors Construction (WECC), who are building the tunnels for the first phase of this project, have worked closely with Metrolinx and City staff for several months to secure the proper permits for the removal of trees along the Eglinton Avenue West corridor at various sites.

WECC is compensating for the removal of trees along Eglinton Avenue West. Metrolinx, along with partners TRCA and in coordination with the City of Toronto, are committed to a tree replanting program that has already proactively replanted 400 trees at the Scarlett Mills Park with further replanting scheduled for this year.
