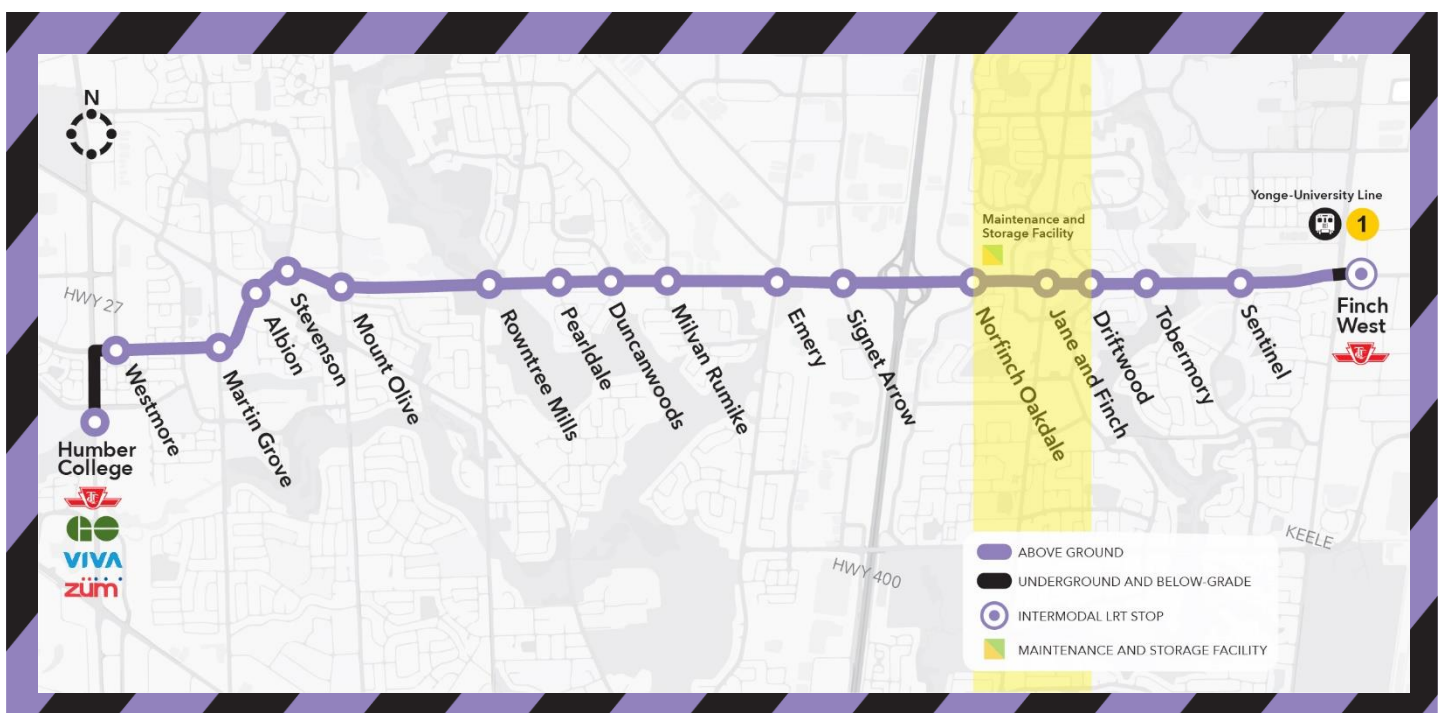


Community update of works Driftwood Ave. to Norfinch Dr./Oakdale Rd.

February 2021 – April 2021



What?

As part of the construction of the future Finch West Light Rail (LRT) line, work continues across Finch Ave. W., from Driftwood Ave. to Norfinch Dr. to relocate utilities and widen the road. Guideway work in this area will start in mid-February, ramping up at the Maintenance and Storage Facility (MSF) and between Driftwood Ave. and Norfinch Dr./Oakdale Rd. as crews work to complete the MSF building and to install a section of guideway in summer 2021 to test light rail vehicles.

Work will primarily occur between 7 am to 11 pm, however, some work will need to be accomplished overnight. Work that causes higher noise or vibration levels will be prioritized before 11 pm and monitored, if needed.

ONGOING AND UPCOMING ACTIVITIES

Driftwood Ave. to Norfinch Dr.

- Storm and sanitary sewer installation work across Finch Ave. W. continue, including overnight work at Finch Ave. W. and Jane St.
- Activities to widen Finch Ave. W. continue.
- Telecommunications work continues.
- Work inside the MSF site continues, including duct bank, retaining wall, track, and overhead catenary system (OCS) installations, as well as mechanical and electrical work inside the MSF building.
- The guideway work includes pole foundations, manholes, duct banks, trackwork and overhead cabling.
- Crews will start the guideway work at Jane St. and Finch Ave. W. intersection, partially restricting the north and southbound lanes on Jane St. from mid-February to late March 2021.
- Once the guideway is installed at Jane St. and Finch Ave. W., a portion of York Gate Blvd., north of Finch Ave. W. will be closed for two (2) months, starting in late March 2021. Closer to the start of the closure, a separate notice with more details will be shared with affected community members.
- Overnight work to expect throughout the year includes:
 - Activities to rebuild and relocate underground electrical system,
 - Storm and sanitary sewer installation,
 - Road widening,
 - Telecommunication relocations, and
 - Guideway work



WORK HOURS:

- Work will primarily occur Monday to Saturday, from 7 am to 11 pm. There may be work on Sunday, if needed.
- Overnight work will occur Monday to Saturday, from 11 pm to 7 am. There may be overnight work on Sunday, if needed.
- Inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances may delay work activities.

- Lane reductions (at least one lane in each direction remains open)
- Slower traffic
- Local sidewalk closures
- Noise, vibration
- Dust
- Overnight work
- Limited/controlled access to businesses, schools and churches, unless otherwise notified.
- **Water shut offs or lower than usual water pressure.** Affected properties will be notified separately, in advance.
- **Power outages to switch from an old to new electrical system.** There will be advanced notice of planned outages.
- **Sidewalks and intersection closures.** Specific notices will be sent out for scheduled closures.
- TTC bus stops will be closed or relocated, as needed, in consultation with the TTC.
