



FINCH WEST LRT – Transforming Transit in Your Area

Construction Notice

Updated Information as of January 27, 2020

What is the Finch West Light Rail Transit?

The Finch West LRT is a light rail transit project that will bring 11 kilometres of modern, reliable rapid transit to northwest Toronto. It will have 18 stops, including 16 surface stops, plus an underground interchange station at Finch West subway. A below-grade terminal stop at Humber College will connect to other local transit services like GO, MiWay, Viva, and Züm. The Finch West LRT will provide rapid transit for the Jamestown, Rexdale and Black Creek neighbourhoods, as well as vital connections between communities and supporting growth in northwest Toronto.

Installation of temporary traffic signals at Keele St. and Finch Ave. W. and Tangiers Rd. and Finch Ave. W. Late January 2020- February 2020

What:

A crew will continue installing temporary traffic signals on Finch Ave. W. to make space for the construction of future stops and guideway on the Finch West LRT. Once the new temporary traffic signals are installed, the existing signals will be removed.

The next temporary traffic signals will be installed at:

- Keele St. and Finch Ave. W intersection.
- Tangiers Rd. and Finch Ave. W. intersection.

Hours of Work:

- Work is expected to start as early as January 28, 2020, and last for approximately three weeks.
- Work will occur Monday to Friday between 8 AM and 4 PM. However, partial lane closures will occur only during off-peak hours (between 9 AM and 3 PM).
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

What to Expect:

- A crew will install temporary traffic signals and remove existing ones.
- Partial lane closures eastbound and westbound on Finch Ave. W. from Keele St. to Tangiers Rd.
- Heavy trucks and equipment will be active in the area.
- Please take care when travelling near work sites.

Traffic Impacts:

- Partial lane closures eastbound and westbound on Finch Ave. W. from Keele St. to Tangiers Rd.
- Construction will be accommodated so that bus stops adjacent to the work are not obstructed.
- A PDO will be available where necessary to support traffic circulation.
- Access to adjacent businesses and residences will be maintained.
