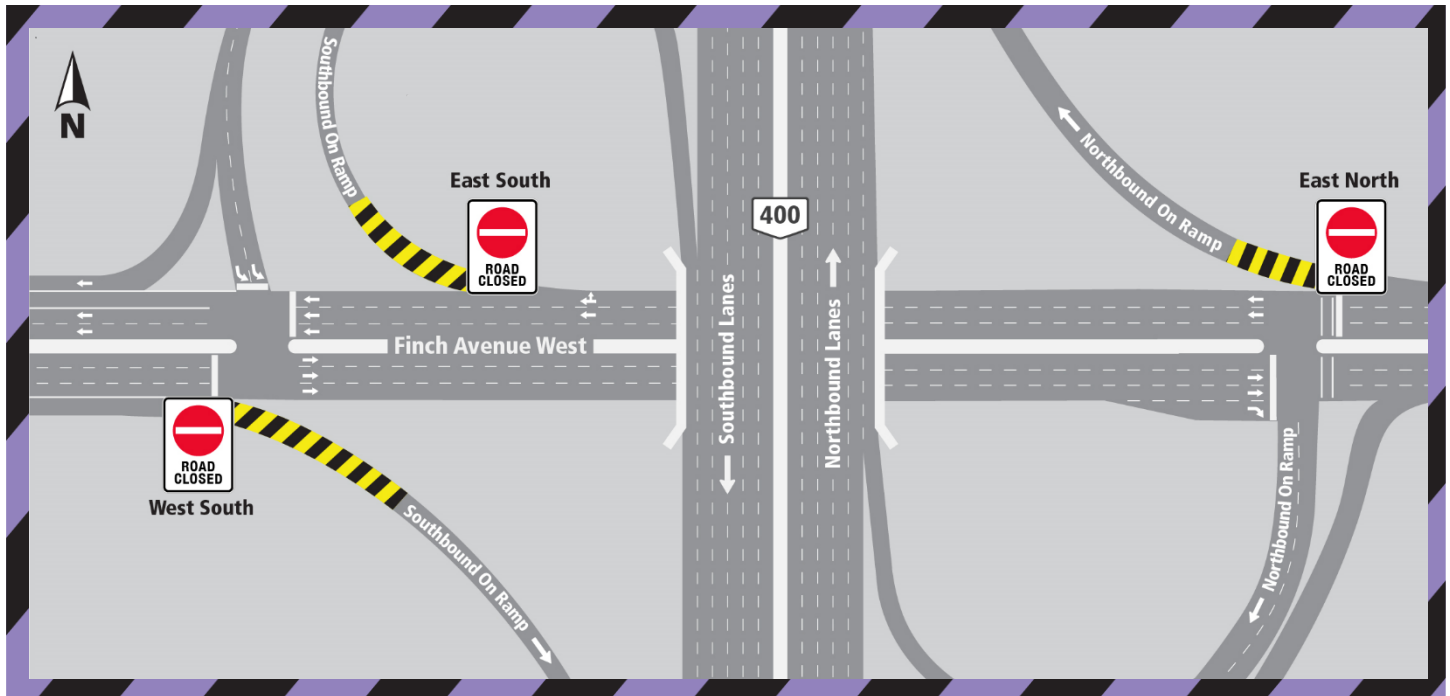


Road Closures for Utilities Installation Finch Avenue West and Highway 400

October 19 - November 1, 2021



What?

As part of the preparatory works for the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT) line, crews have been relocating utilities in the vicinity of Finch Avenue West and Highway 400.

Crews will install storm sewers and conduct road works, including curb and pedestrian bridge installation Finch Avenue West and Highway 400. The work will be done in five stages:

- **Stage 1** - South-East/West Ramp closure for curb installation on October 19, 2021, at 9:00 p.m. till 3:00 p.m. There will be one left turn lane and the middle lane will be the right turn lane.
- **Stage 2** - South-East/West Ramp closure for curb installation on October 20, 2021, at 9:00 p.m. till 3:00 p.m. There will be one left turn lane and the middle lane will be the right turn lane.
- **Stage 3** - East-North Ramp closure for road work from October 22, 2021, at 9:00 p.m. till October 25, 2021, at 5:00 a.m.
- **Stage 4** - South-East Ramp closure for sewer works on October 23, 2021, from 7:00 a.m. till 8:00 p.m.

- **Stage 5** – West -South Ramp closure for pedestrian tunnel installation from October 28, 2021, at 9:00 p.m. till November 1, 2021 at 5:00 a.m.

Noise and vibration levels will be monitored to make sure they are always within permitted ranged



WORK HOURS:

- Tuesday, October 19, 2021, from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 pm.
- Wednesday, October 20, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.
- Friday, October 22, 2021, from 9:00 p.m. till Monday, October 25, 2021, at 5:00 a.m.
- Saturday, October 23, 2021, from 7:00 a.m. till 8:00 p.m.
- Thursday, October 28, 2021 from 9:00 p.m. till Monday, November 1, 2021, at 5:00 a.m.
- Higher noise or vibration activities are scheduled before 11 pm and levels are monitored.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Heavy trucks and equipment in the area.
- During these works, nearby properties may experience noise, dust and/or vibration
- Nearby businesses and residents can expect noise from excavators, bobcats, vacuum trucks and other construction equipment caused by road work activities.
- Water trucks to manage dust around the construction area, if needed
- Flaggers on site when necessary, to ease traffic access and ensure public safety.
- Please obey all posted construction signs and do not enter the work zones.
- Please take extra care when walking near work sites. Always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.
- Unforeseen circumstances and weather may affect the schedule.

PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC AND TRANSIT DETAILS:

- Access to schools, churches, and businesses will be maintained, unless otherwise communicated.
- Access for Emergency Vehicles will be maintained.
- TTC bus stops will be closed or relocated away from work zones, as needed.
- Relocation of bus stops is done in consultation with TTC.
- Access to TTC will be maintained at all times.
