

Community update of works to expect on Hwy 27 between Humber College Blvd and Finch Ave. W.

March 2021 - May 2021



What?

As part of the construction of the future Finch West Light Rail (LRT) line, work continues across Highway 27 from Finch Avenue to Humber College Boulevard. Crews are relocating dry and wet utilities in the vicinity. Excavation for the portal has started on Finch Ave. W., the installation of steel piles to support excavation of the portal and stop is also taking place. Starting in late March, the crew will begin constructing the roof structure at the Humber College Stop. It will provide support across the excavation and allow workers to work underground while traffic travels overhead. Concrete work within the Humber College stop footprint starts in spring - summer 2021.

Work will primarily occur between 7 am to 11 pm, however, some work will need to be accomplished overnight. Work that causes higher noise or vibration levels will be prioritized before 11 pm and monitored.

ONGOING and UPCOMING ACTIVITIES:

- Storm and sanitary sewer installation work across Finch Ave. W. continue, including on Hwy 27 between Finch Ave. and Humber College Blvd.
- Relocation of hydro poles and underground cables continues Highway 27, Finch Ave. W., west of Hwy. 27 to east of Westmore Dr., and on Humber College Blvd., from Hwy. 27 to Arboretum Blvd. Outages will be required to switch power from the old to new infrastructure.
- Crews are installing the retaining walls and in February 2021 started inserting lagging between the piles and tie backs to provide further support of excavation on Hwy 27.
- Excavation began in February at Finch Ave. and Hwy. 27 for the portal.

- Excavation is expected to begin in mid-March at the site of the Humber College stop.
- The roof slab structure installation will begin at the end of March.
- Concrete work within the footprint of the Humber College stop (i.e., base slabs, walls) starts in spring/summer 2021.
- Humber College Blvd. will have reduced lanes until the end of the year. Traffic is currently on the south side of the road but is expected to flip to the north side in summer.

WORK HOURS:

- Work will primarily occur Monday to Saturday, from 7 am to 11 pm. There may be work on Sunday, if needed.
- Overnight work will occur Monday to Saturday, from 11 pm to 7 am. There may be overnight work on Sunday, if needed.
- Inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances may delay work activities.



IMPACTS:

- Lane reductions (at least one lane in each direction remains open)
- Slower traffic
- Local sidewalk closures
- Noise and vibration
- Dust
- Overnight work
- Power outages to switch from an old to new electrical system. There will be advanced notice of planned outages.
- Sidewalks and intersection closures. Specific notices will be sent out for scheduled closures.
- TTC bus stops will be closed or relocated, as needed, in consultation with the TTC.
- Transit access at all times. Updates available at www.ttc.ca
