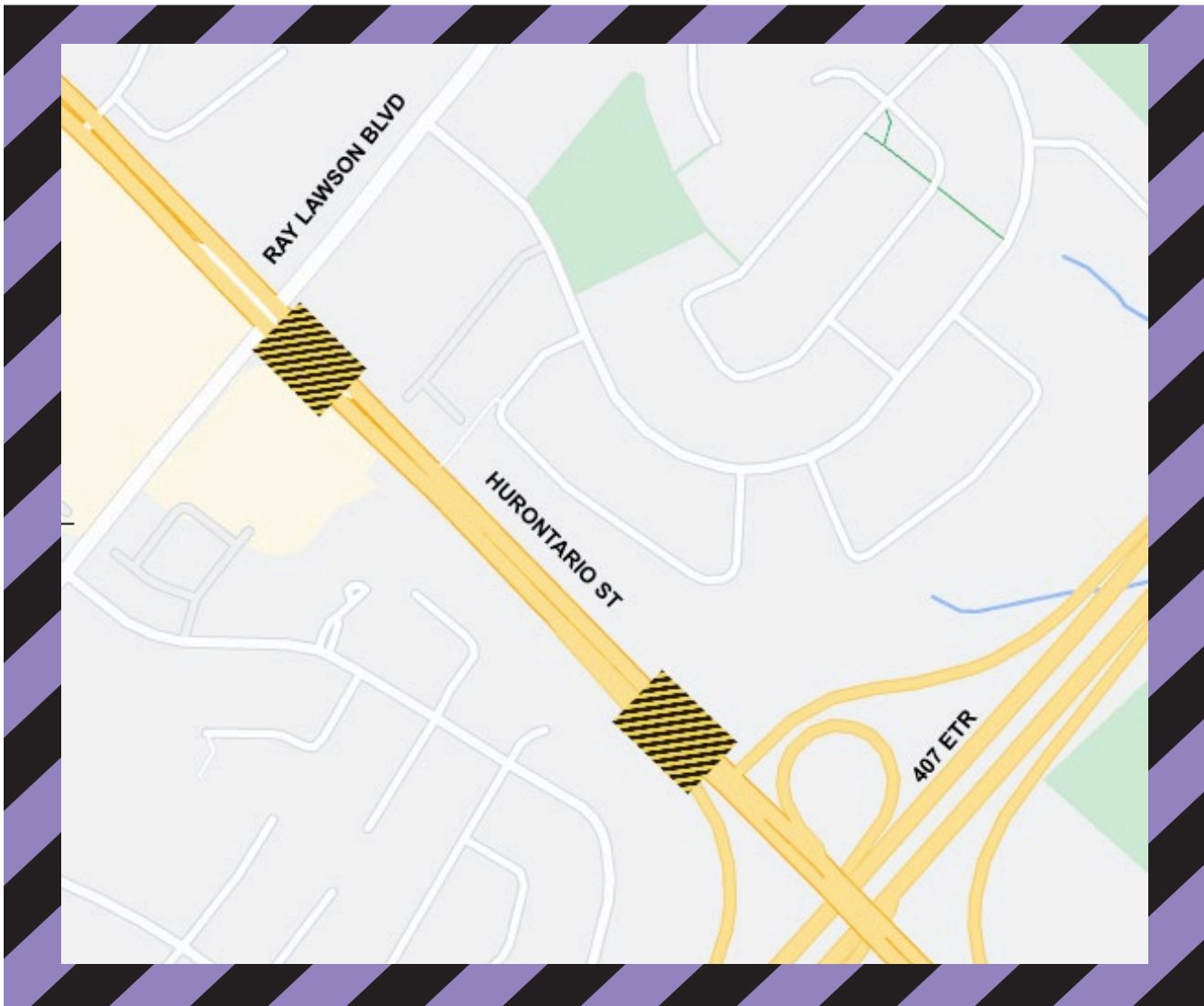


# Alectra duct bank installations on Hurontario Street, between 407 ETR and Ray Lawson Boulevard

Beginning September 6 - 22, 2022



## What work is taking place?

Construction crews will be installing duct banks on Hurontario Street between Ray Lawson Boulevard and Highway 407 ETR. These works are scheduled to begin on **September 6 - September 22, 2022, from 7 pm to 7 am**.

Metrolinx has a noise bylaw exemption for this overnight work, however every effort will be made to minimize disruptions. Residents near the work site may hear noise or feel vibrations caused by construction activities and equipment. Temporary lane reductions will also be required, and work may be rescheduled due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

## Keeping you in mind

We understand that we are building this transformational transit project in a residential area and that overnight work is not ideal. We appreciate your patience and will complete this work as efficiently as possible to get things back to normal for you. We have a dedicated community relations team in place to work with residents and businesses in Peel Region through the construction and operation of this transformational project.

### TIMING

- Work is scheduled from September 6 - 22, 2022
- Overnight construction will occur between 7 pm to 7 am.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

### TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Temporary lane reductions will be required on Hurontario Street between Hwy 407 ETR and Raw Lawson Boulevard.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

### WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

### TRANSIT DETAILS

- Due to lane reductions along Hurontario Street, delays can be expected on Brampton Transit and Züm routes.

### PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when walking or cycling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing the public such as detours and dismounting.
