


# Utility Relocation and Road Widening on Hurontario Street from Bartley Bull Parkway to South of Highway 407

Updated: January 2022



## What work is taking place?

To accommodate construction of the Hurontario LRT, utility services between the city boundary line, south of Highway 407, and Bartley Bull Parkway will need to be relocated. This includes new watermain, storm, sanitary systems as well as electrical and telecommunication infrastructure. This infrastructure is on the main artery servicing residents and businesses along Hurontario Street and must be re-routed to ensure reliable service to customers. Works will begin with the removal of the remaining median and installation of temporary traffic lights. The work will take place in two stages. Stage one will begin on the east and west side of Hurontario Street between Highway 407 and Lancashire Lane. Once complete, stage two will begin at Lancashire Lane moving north towards Bartley Bull Parkway.

### TIMING

- Work started in October 2021 and will last approximately one year.
- Work will generally occur between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. However, extended hours, night shifts and weekend works may be scheduled as required.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

### TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Lane reductions will be required on Hurontario Street between Highway 407 and Bartley Bull Parkway.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Temporary traffic signal heads will be shifted to align with the shift in traffic lanes.

### WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Access to properties will be maintained through at least one driveway whenever possible.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

### TRANSIT DETAILS

- MiWay, Züm, and Brampton Transit will continue to operate with regular service.
- Due to lane reductions along Hurontario Street, delays can be expected on Brampton Transit, Züm and MiWay routes.

- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas will be relocated.
- A temporary pedestrian pathway will be provided to access the boarding areas.

### PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk access in the area could be affected.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians & cyclists as detours may be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

### PROPERTY DETAILS

- Please ensure any items, such as signs, benches and underground sprinklers on city owned land have been relocated prior to the beginning of construction.
- For details on your property boundaries, please refer to your land survey, or consult an Ontario Land Surveyor.
