Enbridge Gas Line Relocation on Rathburn Road West from Station Gate Road to City Centre Drive

Beginning Late August 2019

What is the Hurontario Light Rail Transit Project?

The Hurontario LRT will be an 18-kilometre, 19-stop light rail service connecting people from the Port Credit GO station to the Brampton Gateway Terminal. The Hurontario LRT will connect with the Port Credit and Cooksville GO stations, Mississauga Transitway, MiWay and Züm transit lines.

What work is taking place?

To accommodate construction of the Hurontario LRT, Enbridge Gas is required to install a new gas line on along **Rathburn Road West** from **Station Gate Road** to the east side of **City Centre Drive**.


This infrastructure is the main artery servicing the businesses along Rathburn Road West and must be re-routed to ensure reliable service to customers.

Timing

- Work is scheduled to start in late August, 2019 and will last for approximately three months.
- Work will occur between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m., Monday to Saturday.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or any unforeseen circumstances.

What to Expect

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work



Note: at no time will all lanes be closed.

Traffic Details

- During construction hours lane reductions will be required on Rathburn Road West between intersection of Station Gate Road to east of City Centre Drive.
- At a minimum, one lane in each direction will be maintained at all times.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- There will be no impact to property access.

Transit Details

- Due to lane reductions on Rathburn Road West delays are expected between the hours of 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. on all routes servicing the City Centre Transit Terminal.

Pedestrian Details

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas. Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Sidewalk access in the area could be affected. Please watch for signage directing pedestrian traffic.
